Alabama hatcheries set 28.0 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending January 28, a slight decrease from a week ago. Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in **Alabama** were 20.3 million, a slight increase from the previous week. Chicks hatched were 23.8 million, including 4.2 million placed in other states and used for breeder replacements or destroyed. The hatching rate for the state was 85 percent.
