Alabama hatcheries set 27.1 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending February 11, a 1 percent increase from a week ago. Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in **Alabama** were 19.4 million, a 1 percent decrease from the previous week. Chicks hatched were 23.9 million, including 4.8 million placed in other states and used for breeder replacements or destroyed. The hatching rate for the state was 85 percent.
