**Alabama** hatcheries set 28.0 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending February 25, a 1 percent increase from a week ago. Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in **Alabama** were 18.8 million, a 14 percent decrease from the previous week. Chicks hatched were 22.8 million, including 4.6 million placed in other states and used for breeder replacements or destroyed. The hatching rate for the state was 85 percent.
