Arkansas Ranks 15th in U.S. Agricultural Cash Receipts for 2011

Arkansas cash receipts from all commodities totaled \$8.42 billion for the 2011 calendar year, up \$568 million, or 7 percent above 2010. Arkansas ranked 15th in the nation in total agricultural cash receipts, with 17th in total crop cash receipts, and 11th in total livestock cash receipts. Rice and Soybean cash receipts accounted for 65 percent of the total crop cash receipts in 2011. Arkansas rice cash receipts in 2011 accounted for almost 41 percent of the U.S. total rice cash receipts. Broilers accounted for 62 percent of the total livestock cash receipts in 2011 for Arkansas. Cash receipts from livestock and livestock products decreased \$14 million from 2010 to \$4.41 billion.




