AVOCADOS

December 11, 1998

FLORIDA: The forecast of avocados for certified shipments is continued at 900,000 bushels. This is less than the last two seasons when slightly more than 900,000 bushels were shipped.

Some droppage of large variety fruit is reported, after effects of winds from two tropical storms that passed through the Dade County area in October. Amounts are reported limited with some wind scar also reported.

Shipments to December 1 total 730,500 bushels, near the amount two years ago when a total of 918,000 bushels were shipped.

CALIFORNIA: Shipments through November 28 total almost 40,000 bushels, well below last season's 185,000 bushels to the same time. Cold temperatures and very windy weather is reported in early December. Any effects are not known at this time.
