

January 2025 Cattle Survey Sample Size









(1,000) Head and Percent Change from Previous Year
















All Cow and Heifer Slaughter as a Percent of Total Slaughter





January 2025 Sheep and Goat Survey Sample Size









January 1, 2025 Sheep and Lambs (1,000) Head and Percent Change from Previous Year








