

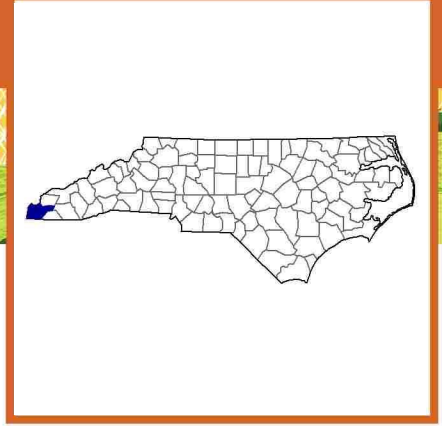


## Cherokee County, North Carolina Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

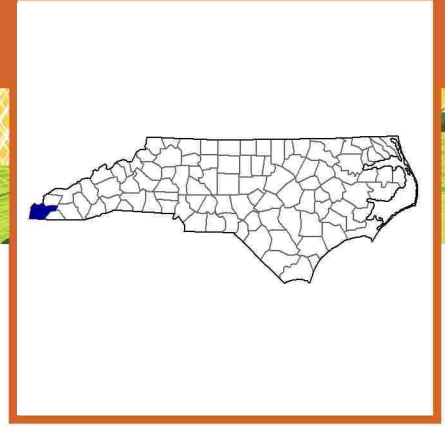


## Cherokee County, North Carolina Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

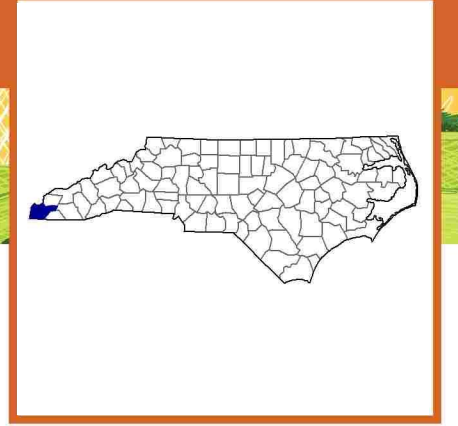

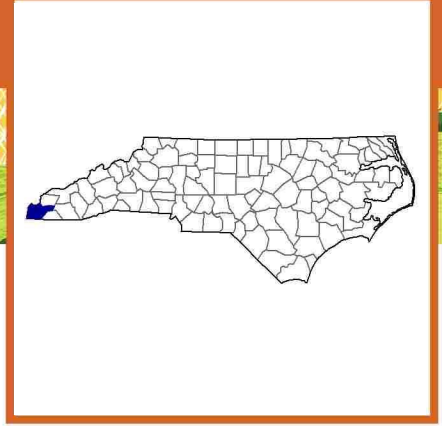

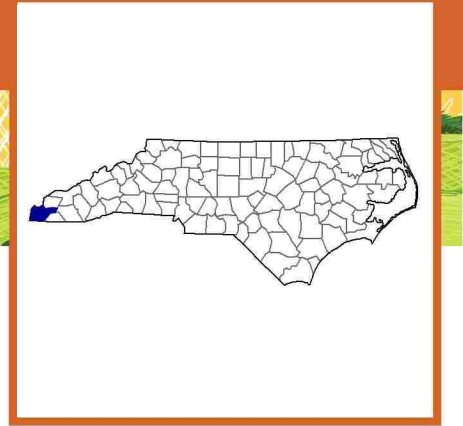
