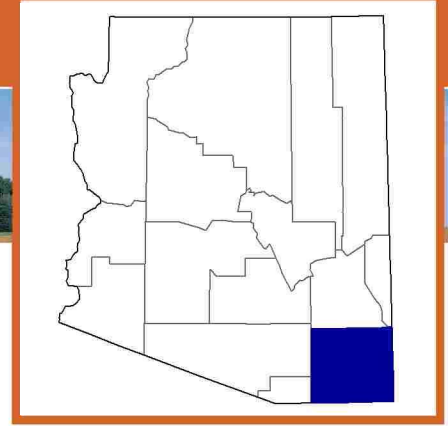

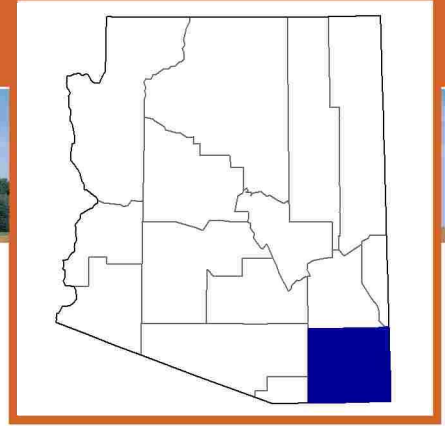
## Cochise County, Arizona Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

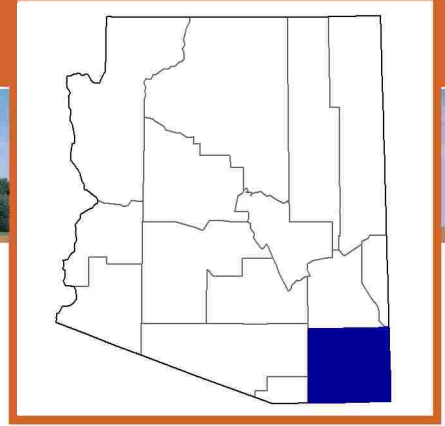

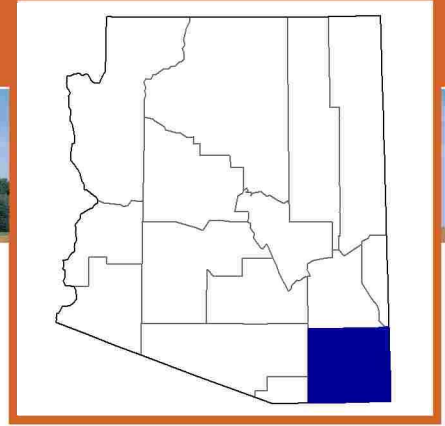
