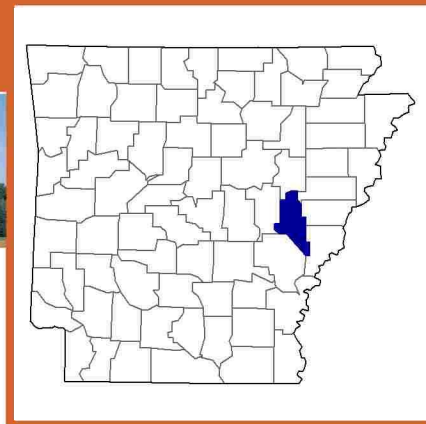




Monroe County, Arkansas Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

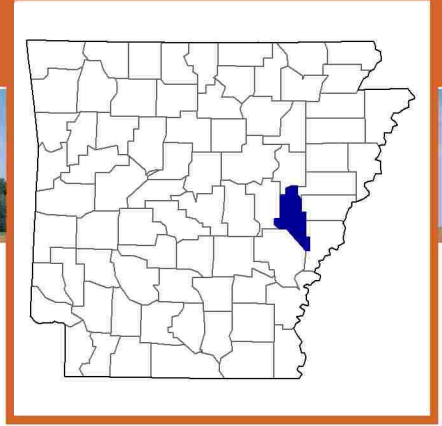

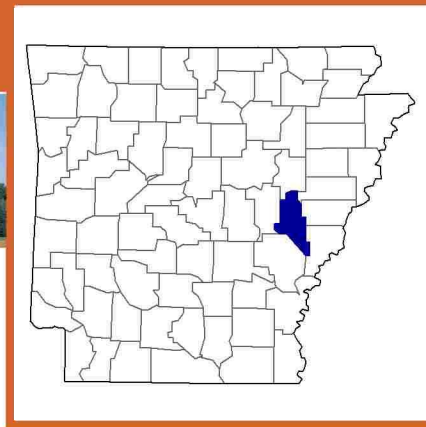

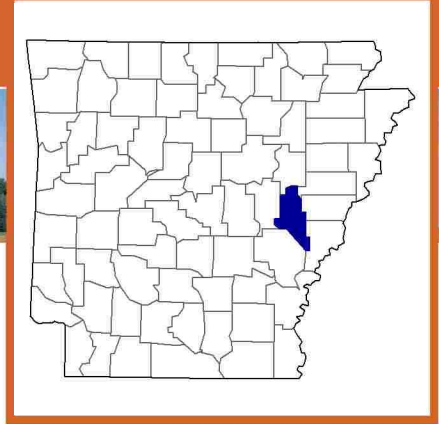
