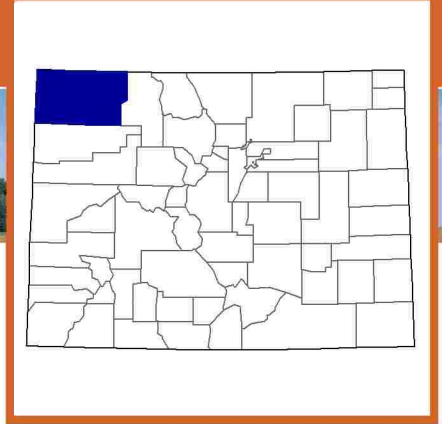

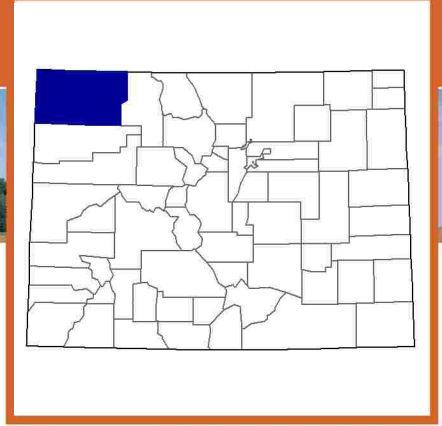


## Moffat County, Colorado Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

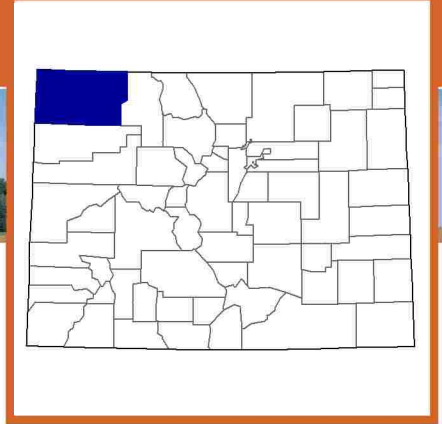


## Moffat County, Colorado Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

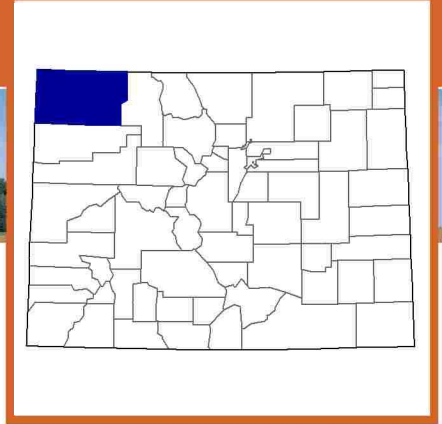

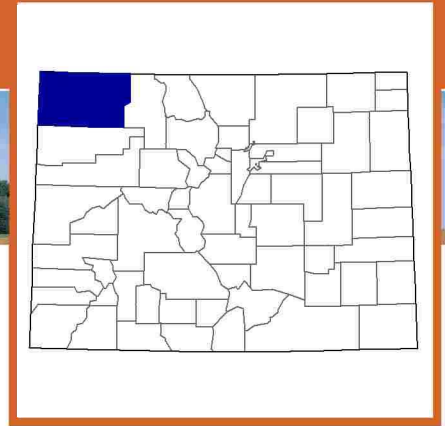

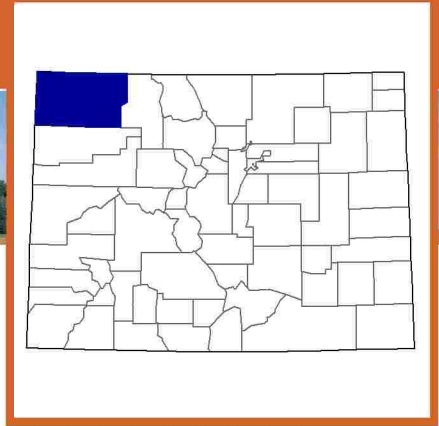
