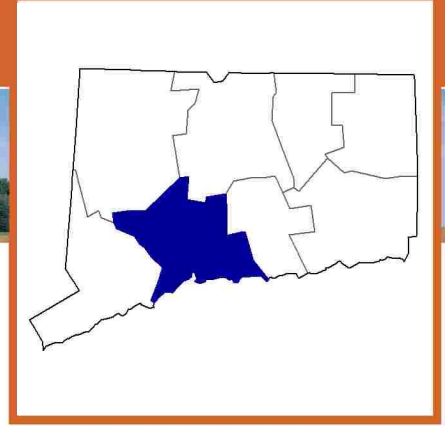

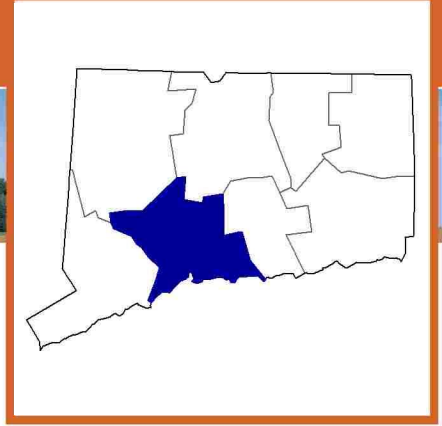
## New Haven County, Connecticut Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

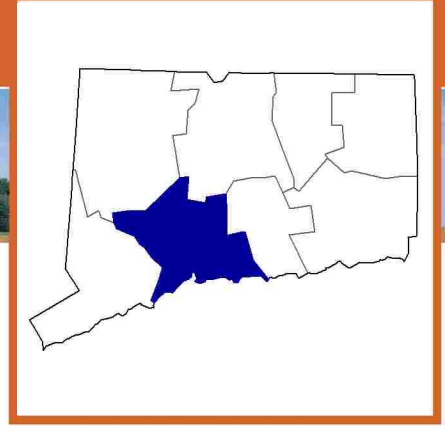

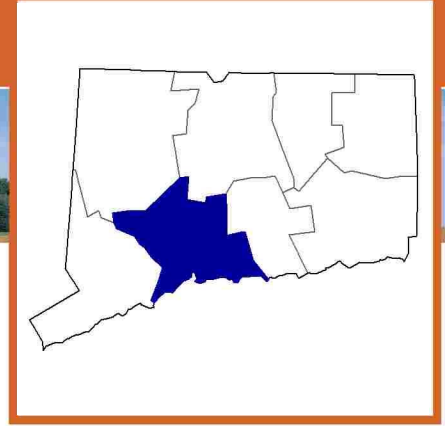

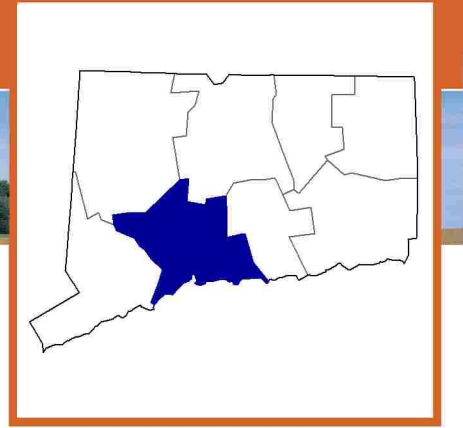
