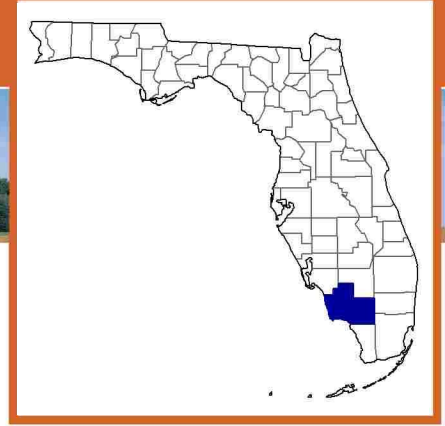

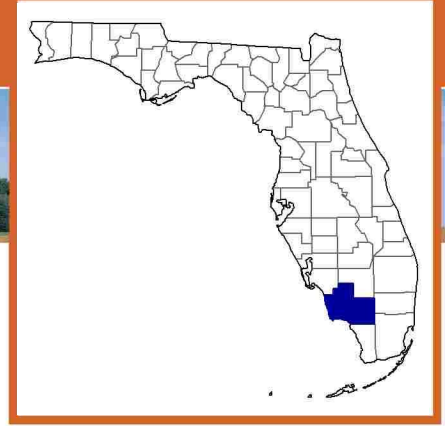


## Collier County, Florida Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

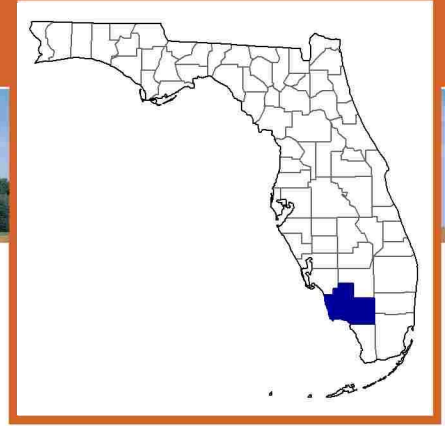

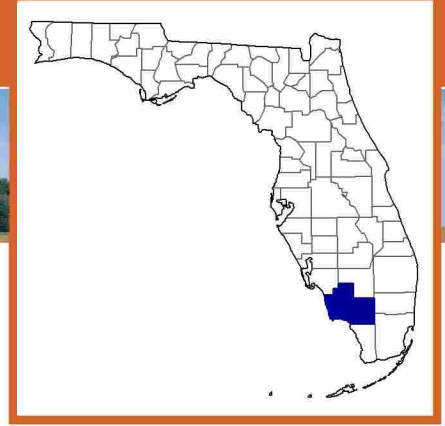

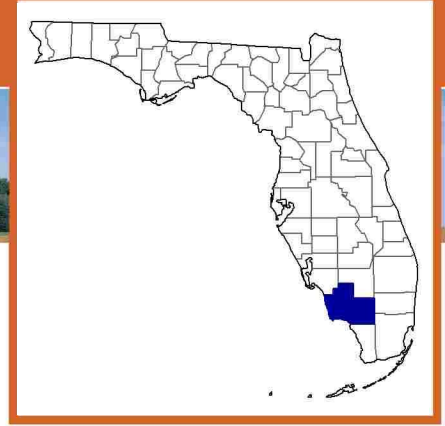
