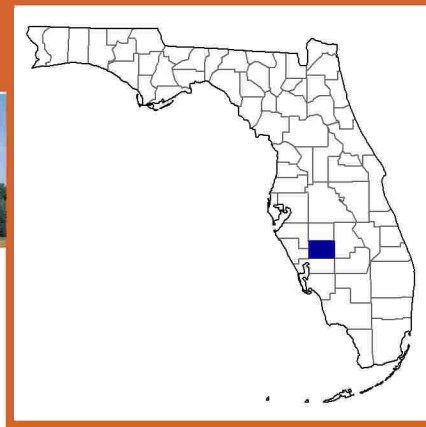


DeSoto County, Florida Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

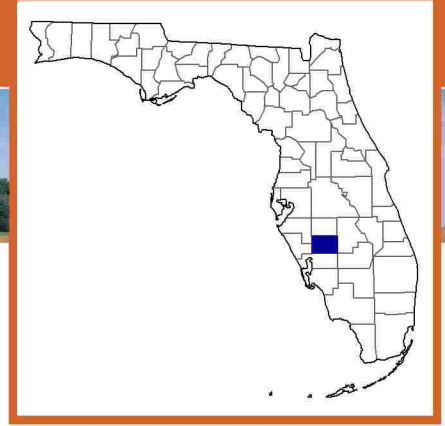

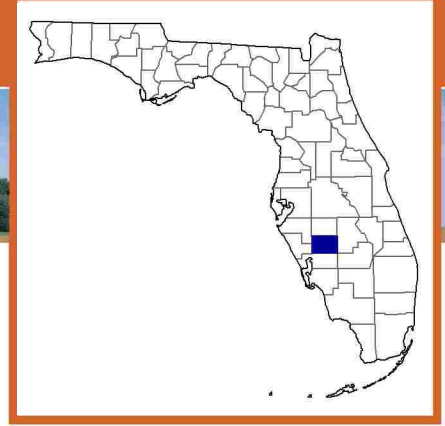

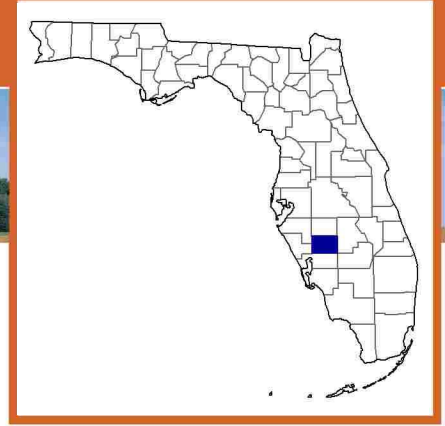

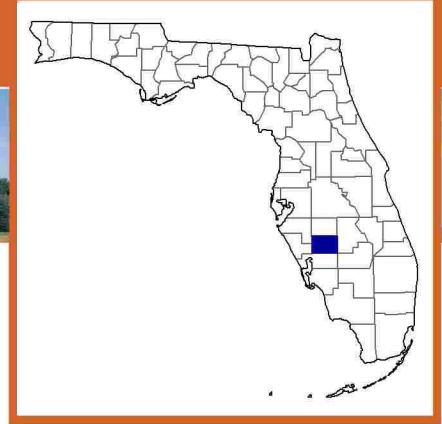
