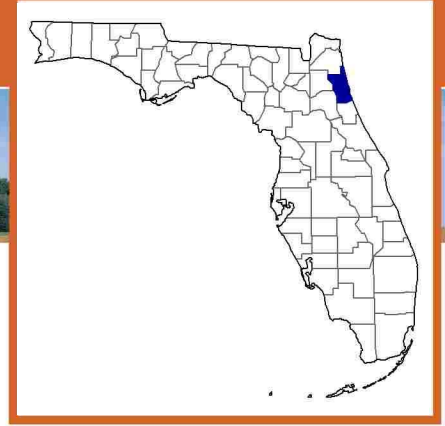

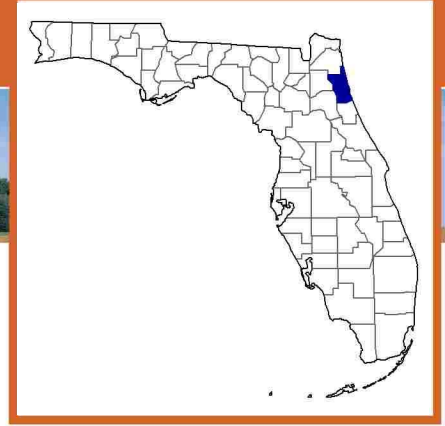


## St. Johns County, Florida Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

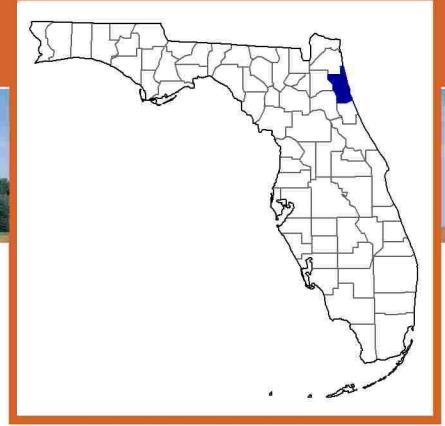


## St. Johns County, Florida Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

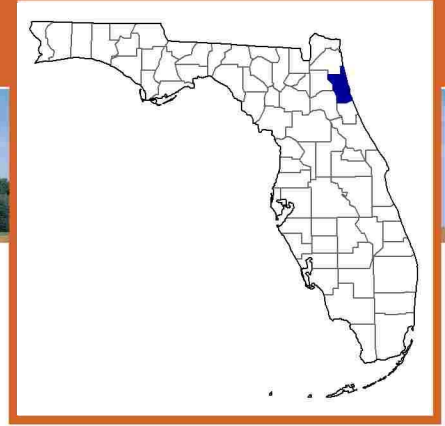

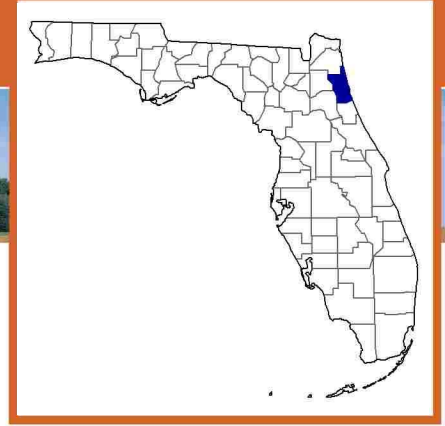

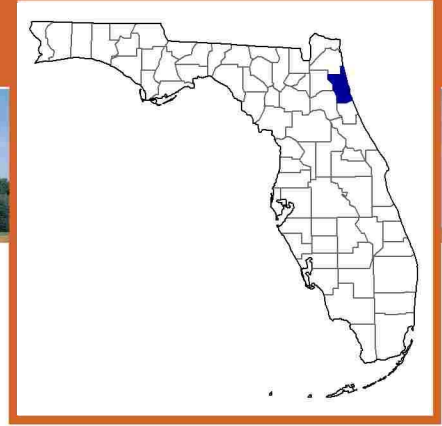
