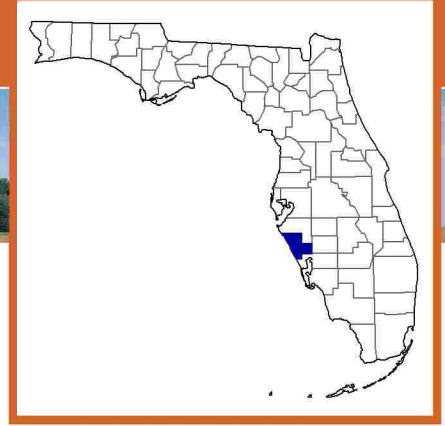


## Sarasota County, Florida Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

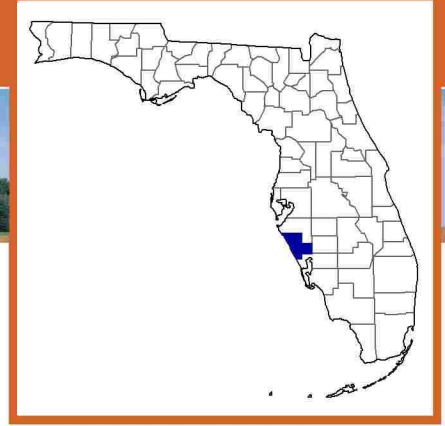


## Sarasota County, Florida Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

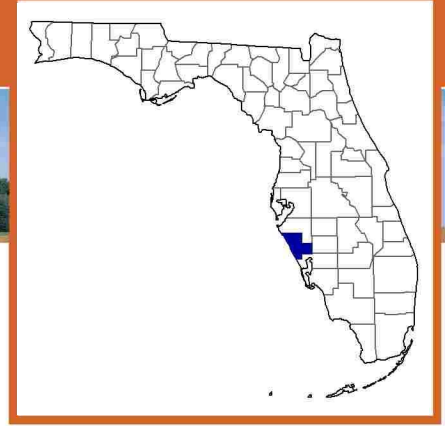


## Sarasota County, Florida Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

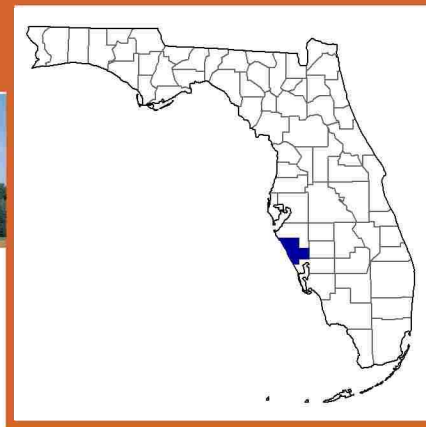

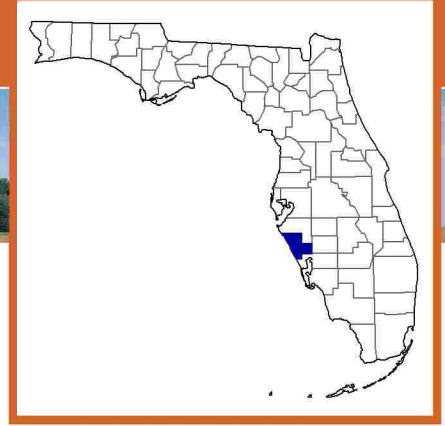

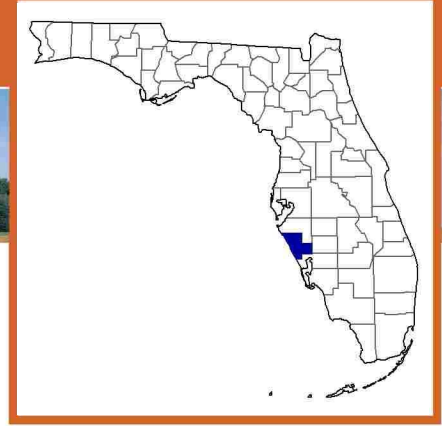
