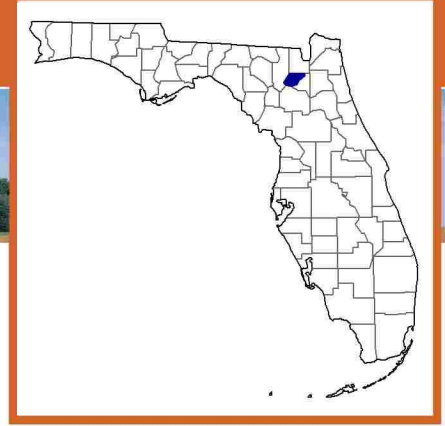


## Union County, Florida Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

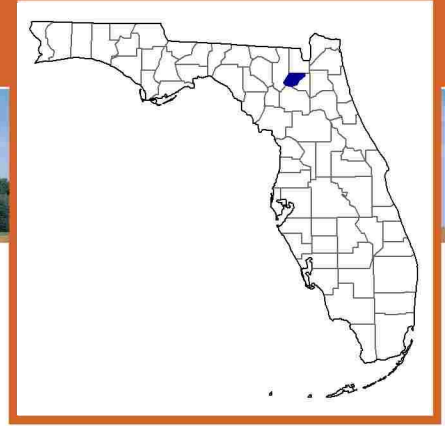


## Union County, Florida Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

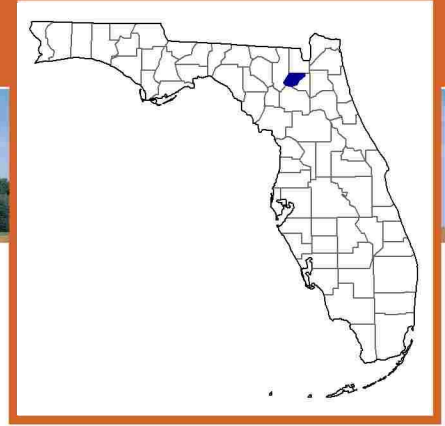

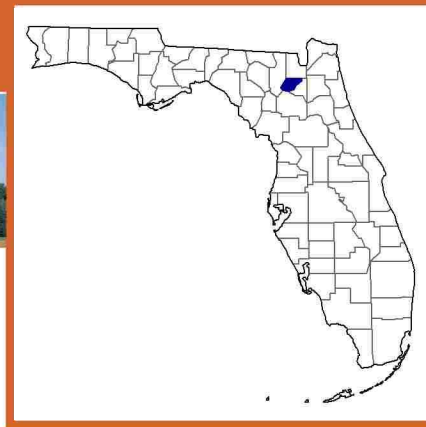

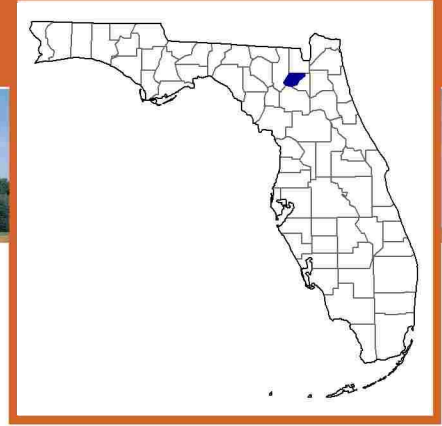
