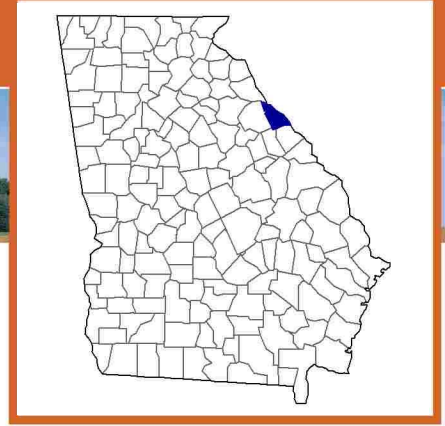

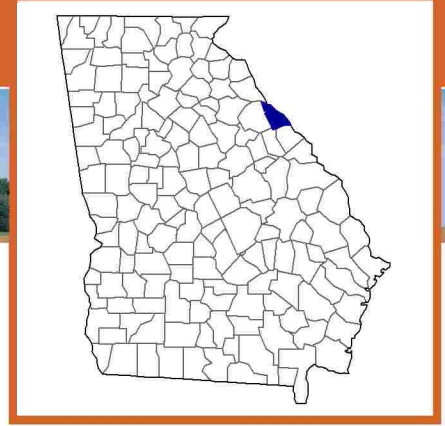


## Lincoln County, Georgia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

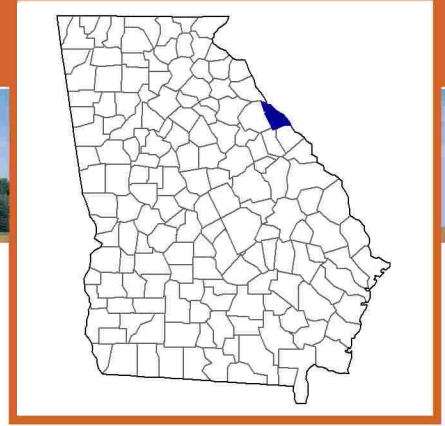

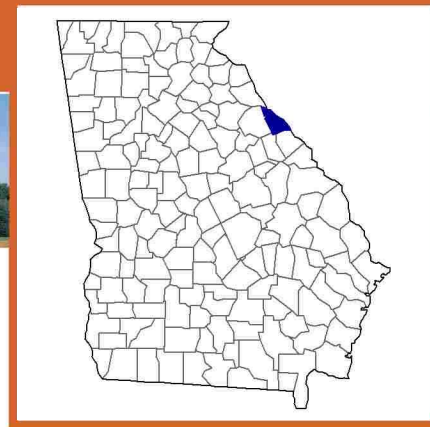

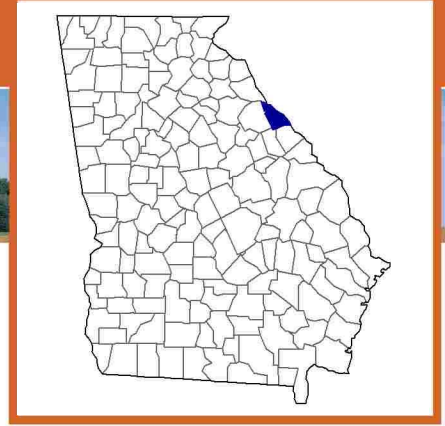

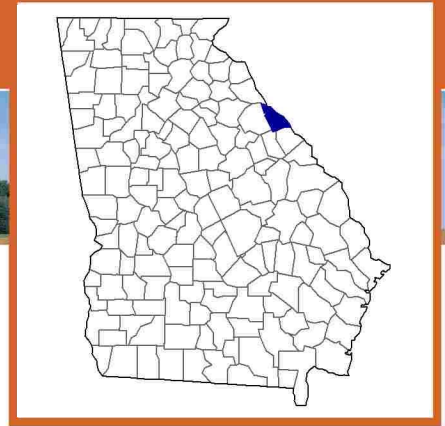
