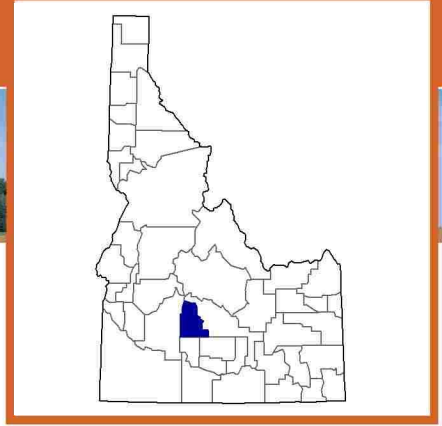

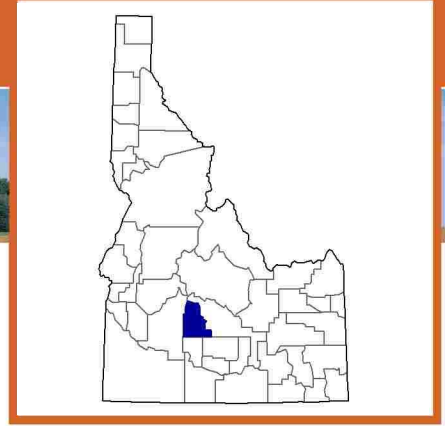


## Camas County, Idaho Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

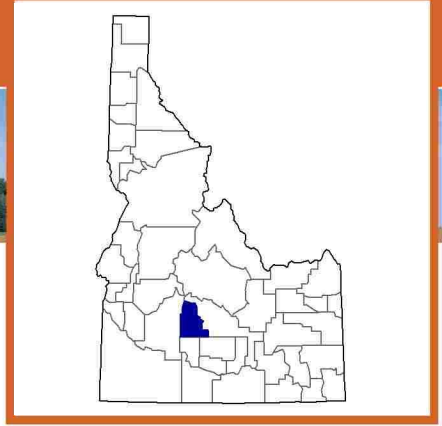


## Camas County, Idaho Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

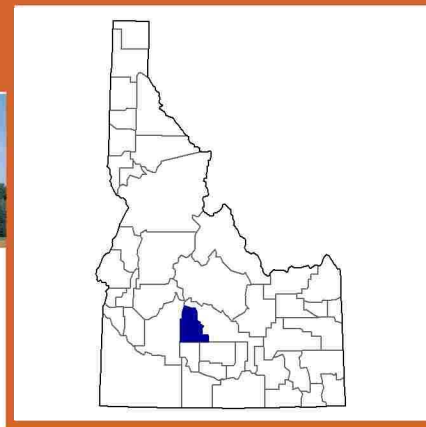

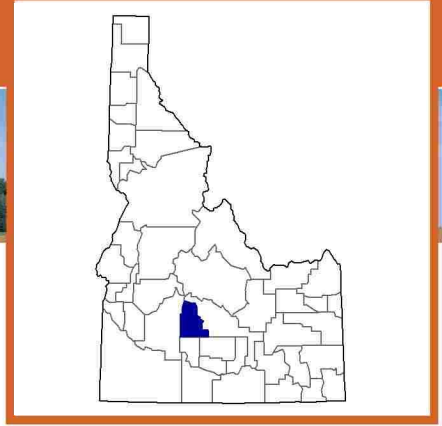

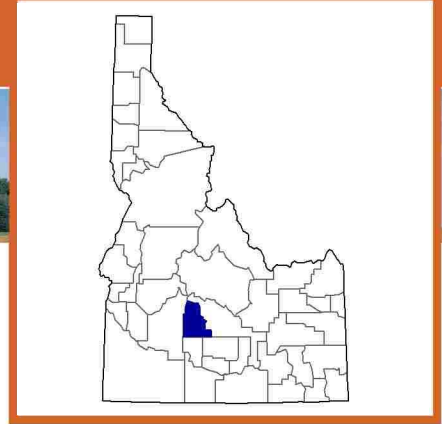
