

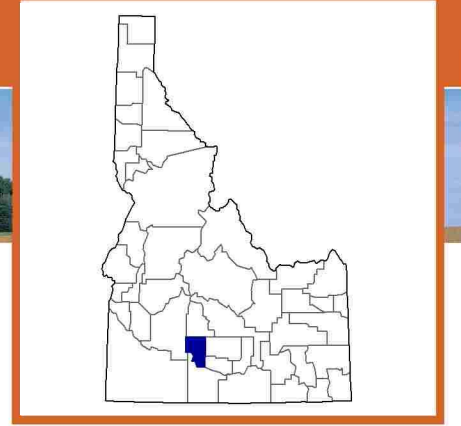

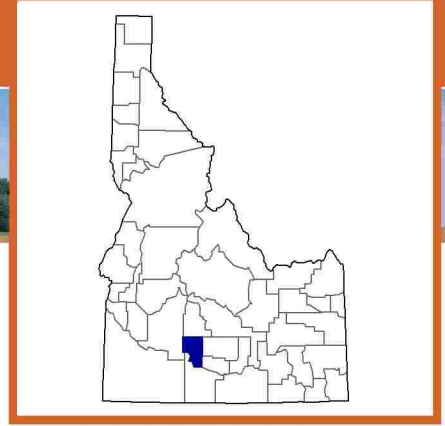


Gooding County, Idaho Farms with Asian Producers^a

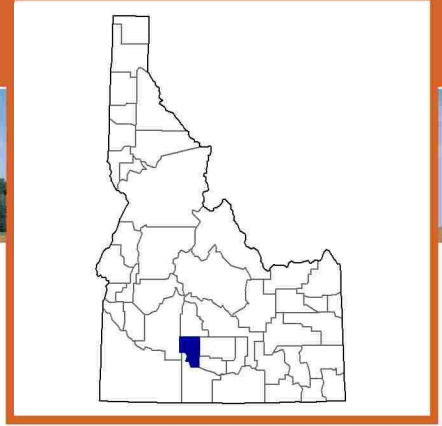

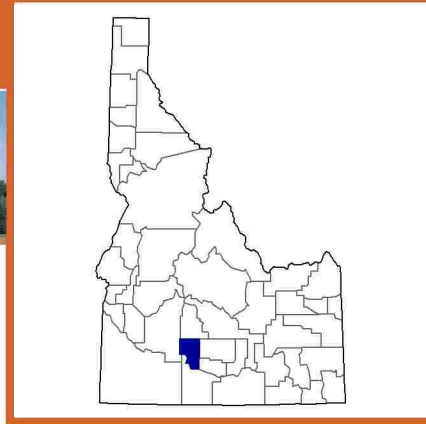

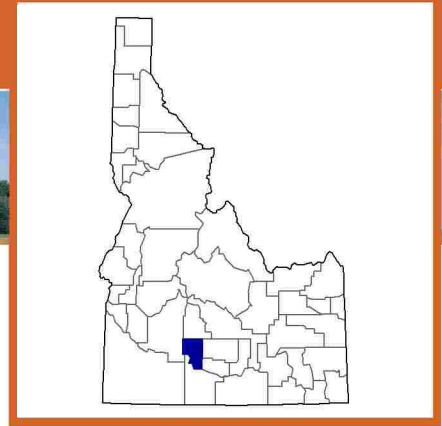
