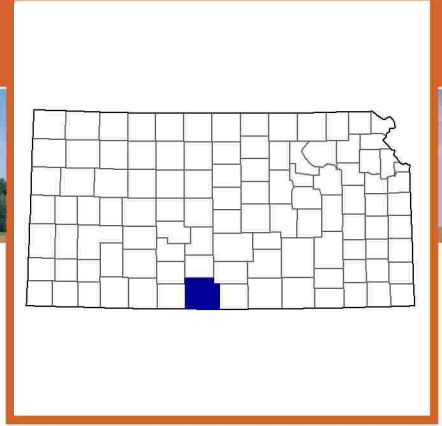

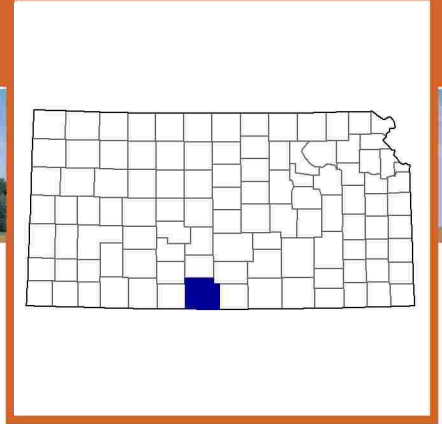


## Barber County, Kansas Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

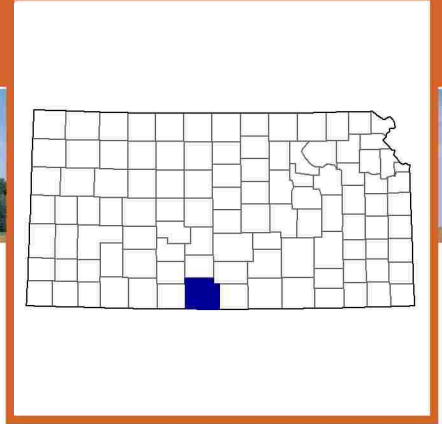

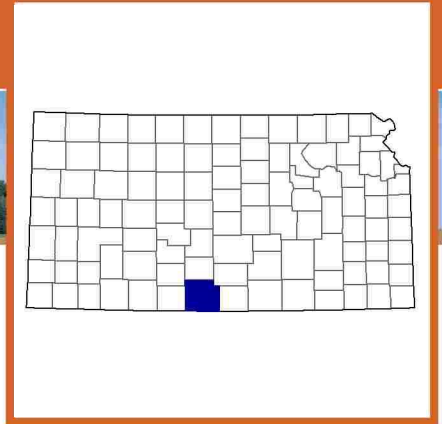

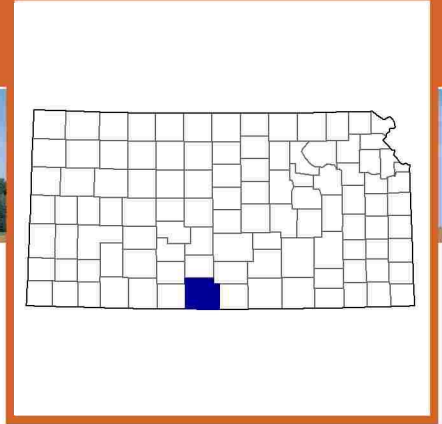

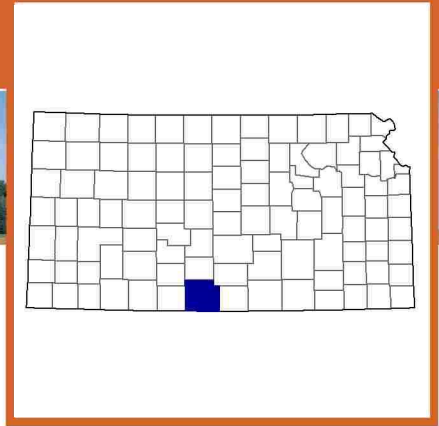
