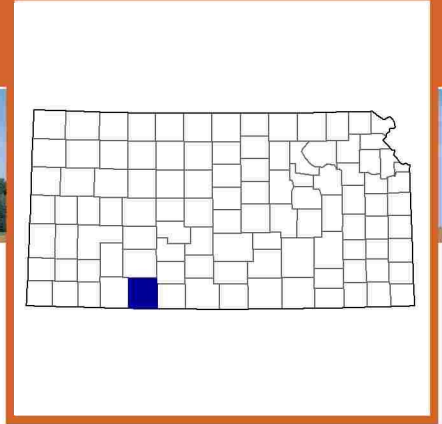


## Clark County, Kansas Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

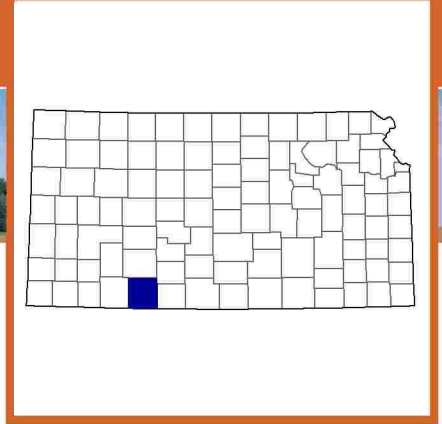


## Clark County, Kansas Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

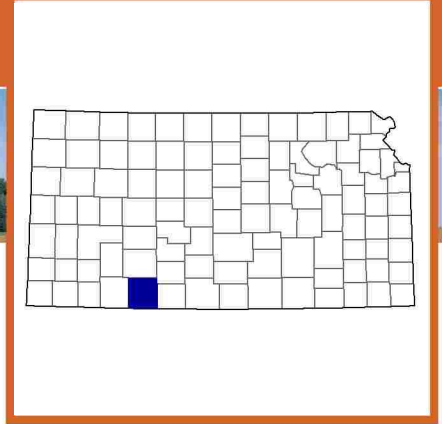

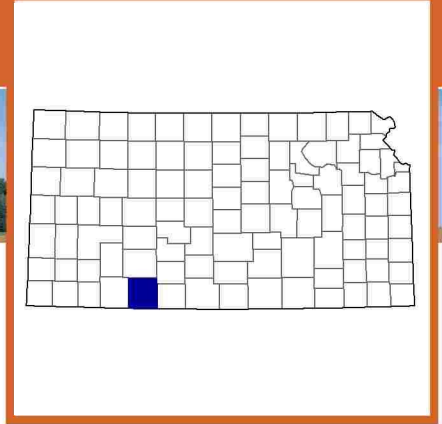

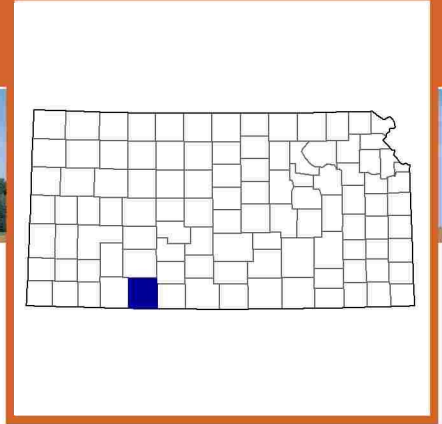

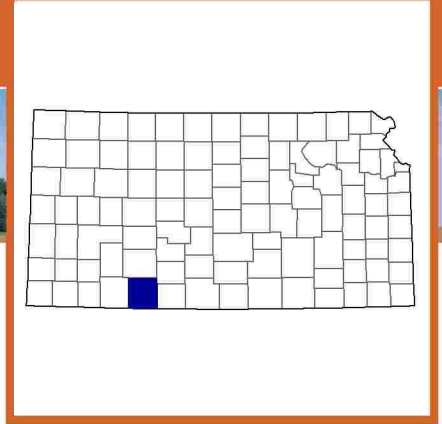
