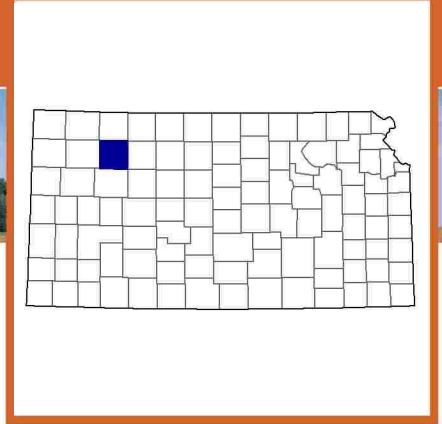


## Sheridan County, Kansas Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

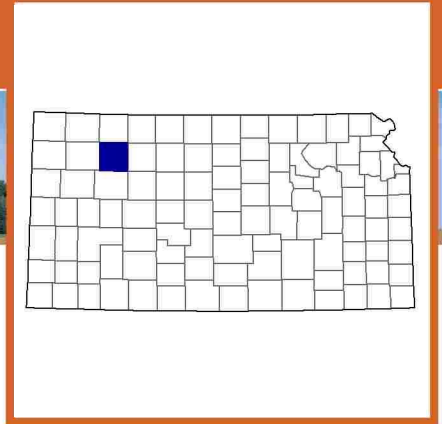


## Sheridan County, Kansas Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

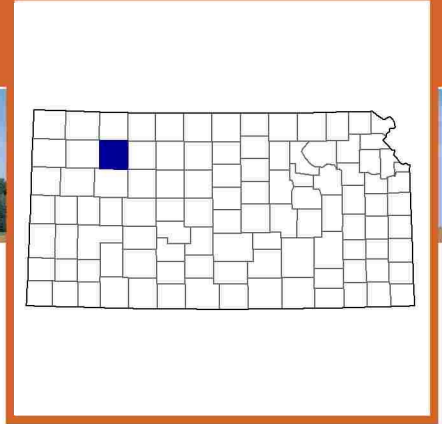


## Sheridan County, Kansas Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

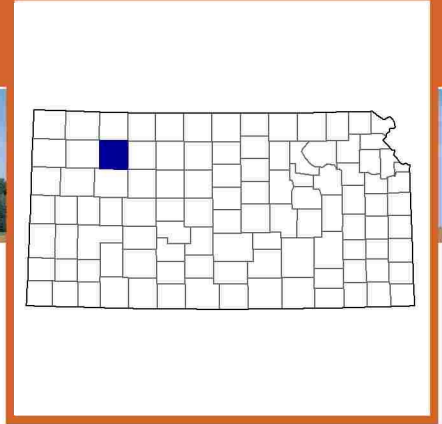

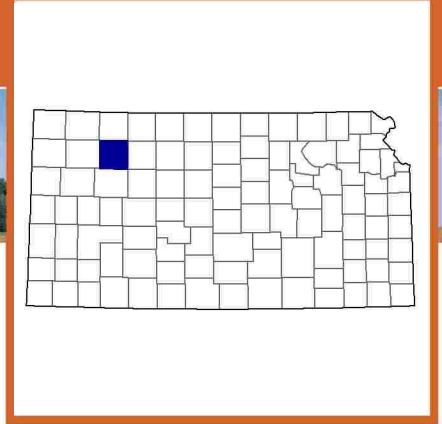

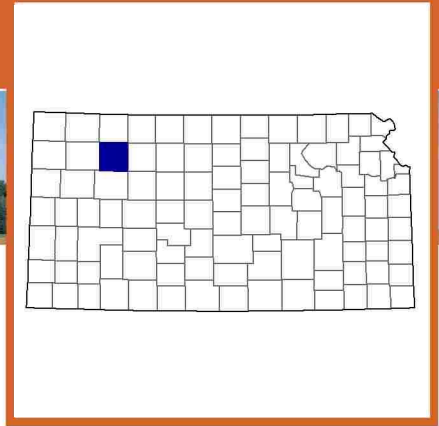
