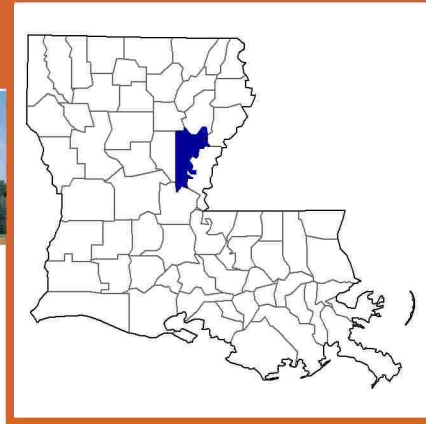




Catahoula Parish, Louisiana Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

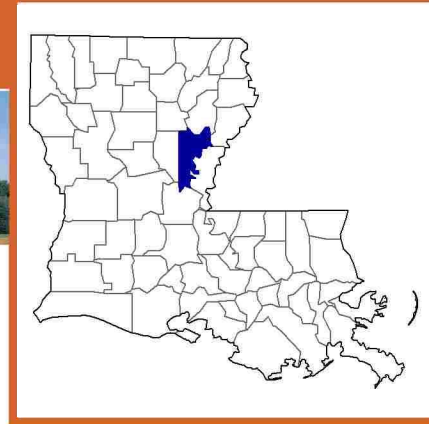

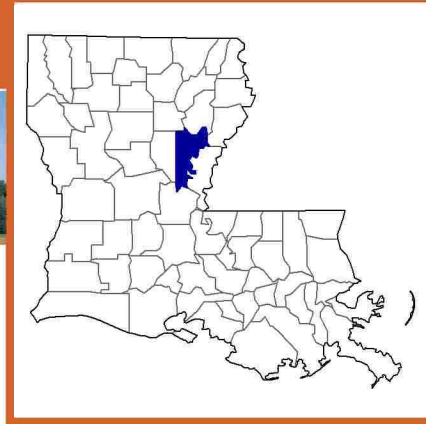
