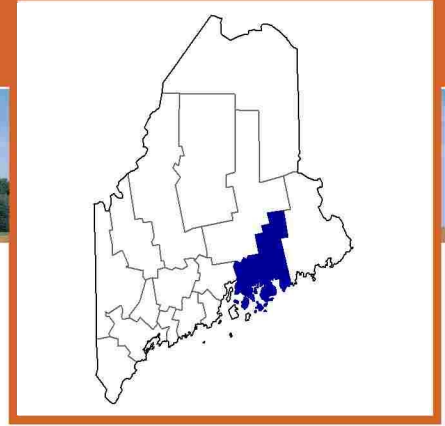


## Hancock County, Maine Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

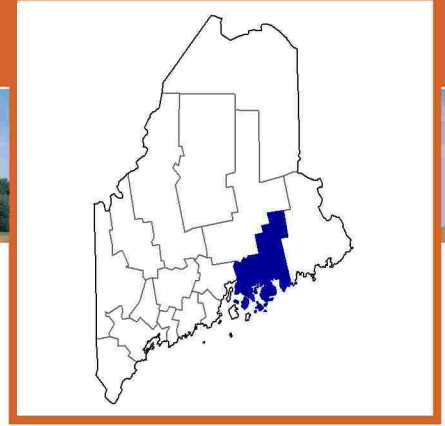


## Hancock County, Maine Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

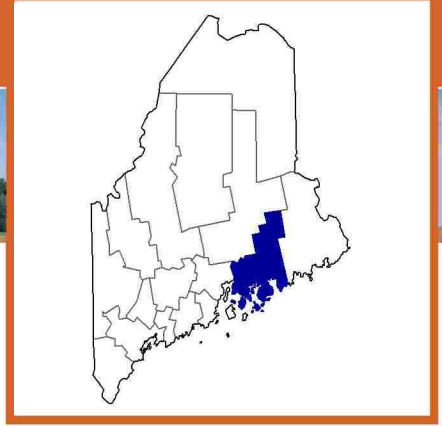

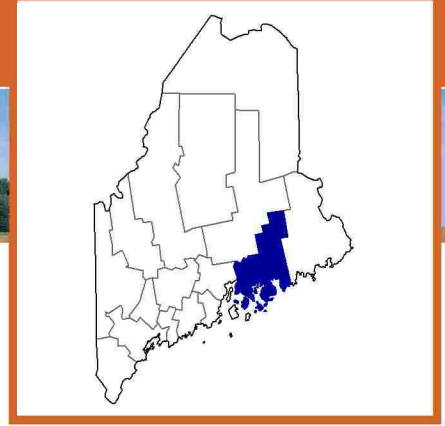

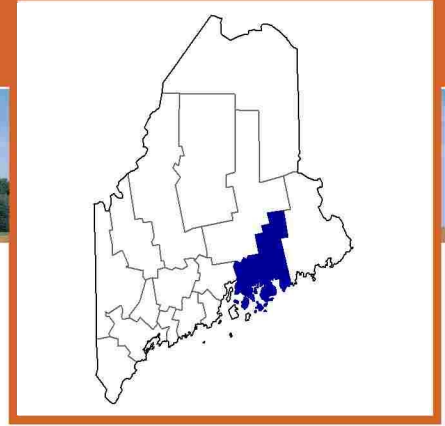

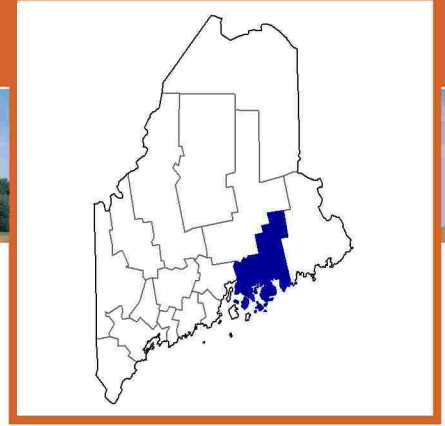
