

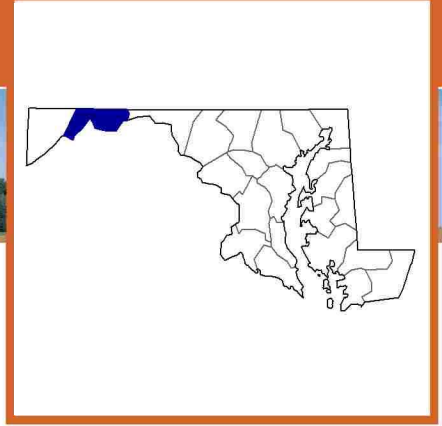


## Allegany County, Maryland Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

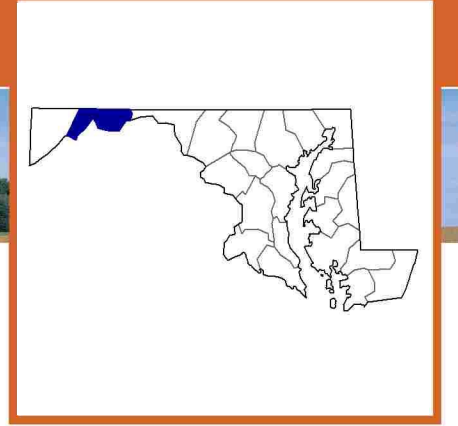


## Allegany County, Maryland Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

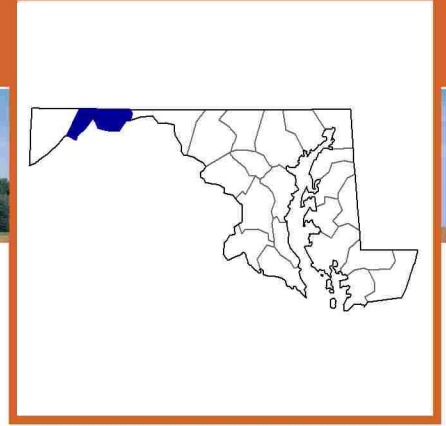

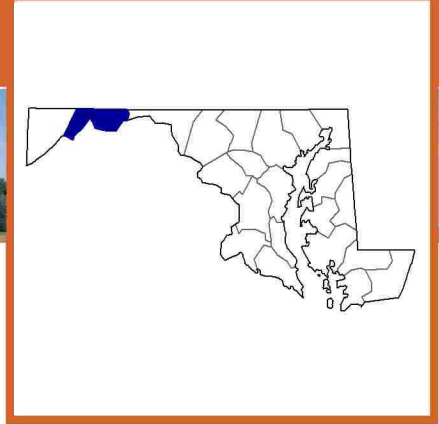
