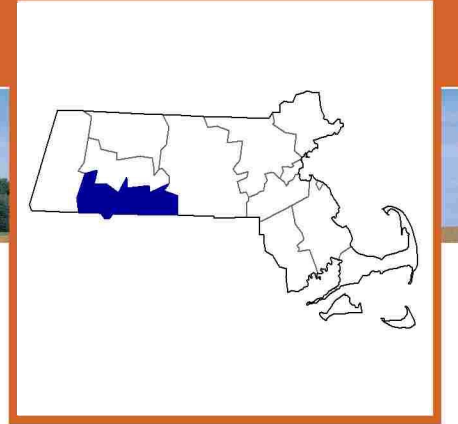


## Hampden County, Massachusetts Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

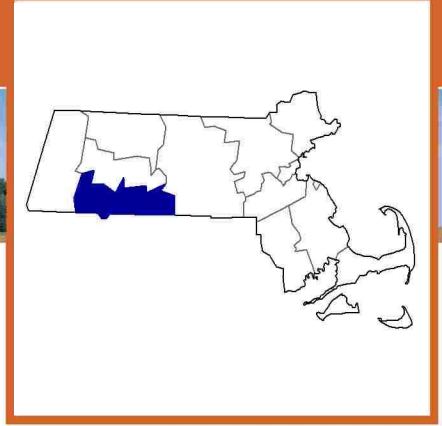


## Hampden County, Massachusetts Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

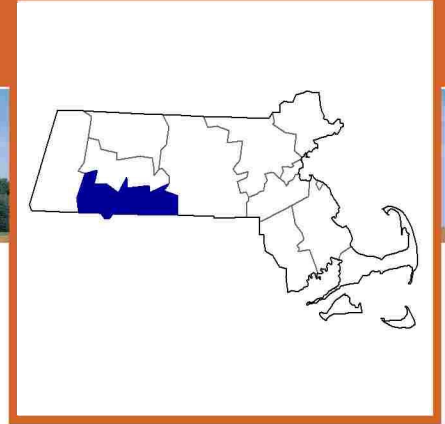


## Hampden County, Massachusetts Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

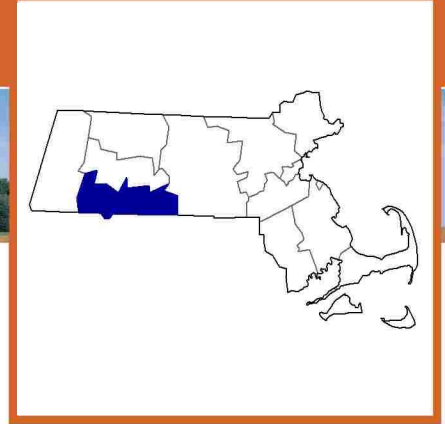

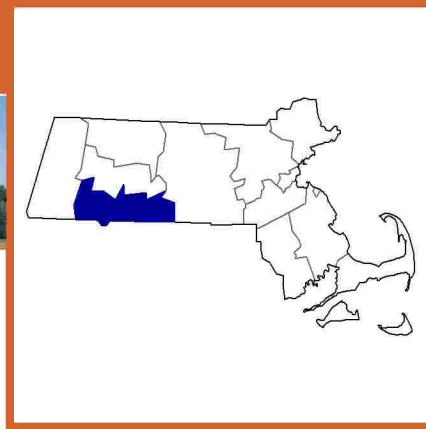
