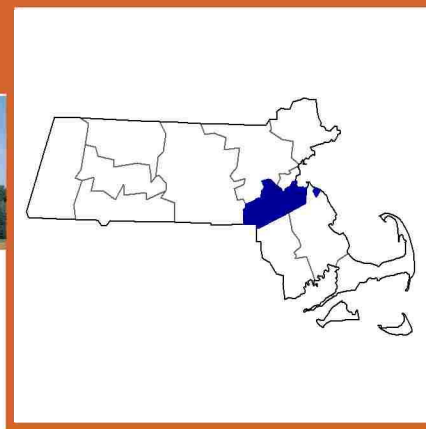

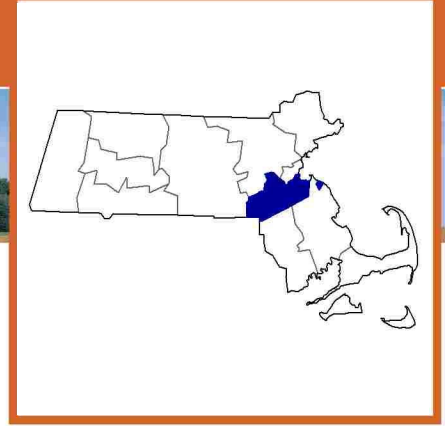


## Norfolk County, Massachusetts Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

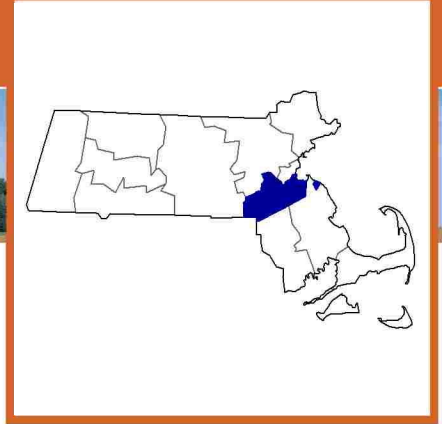

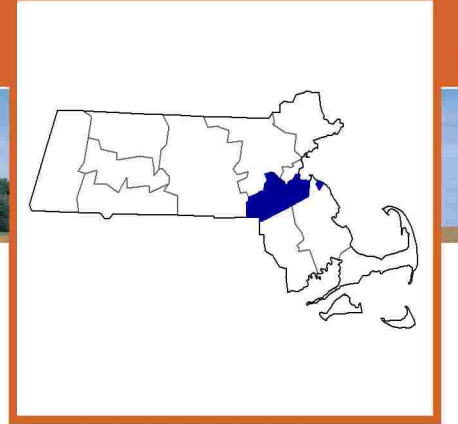

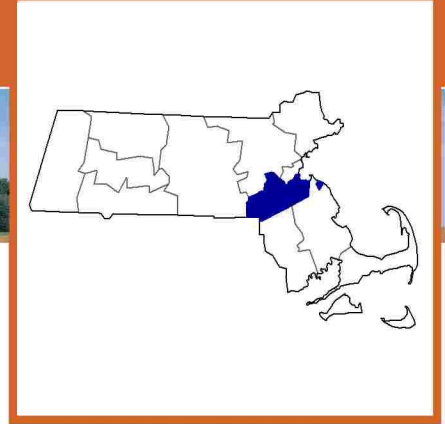

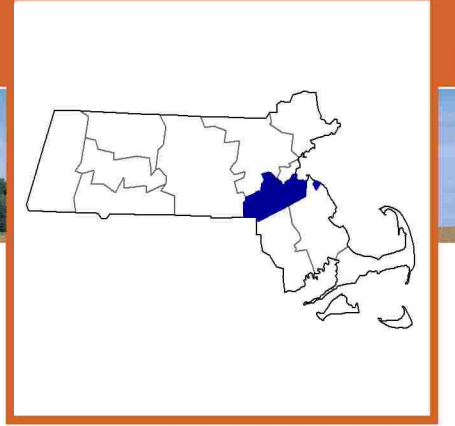
