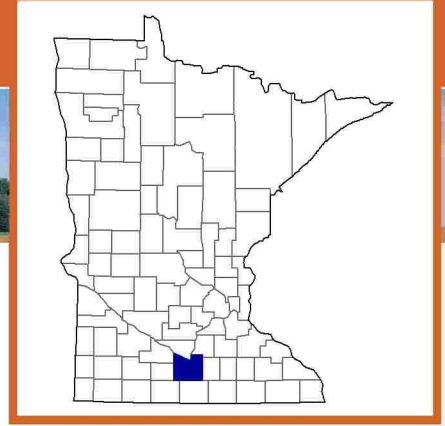

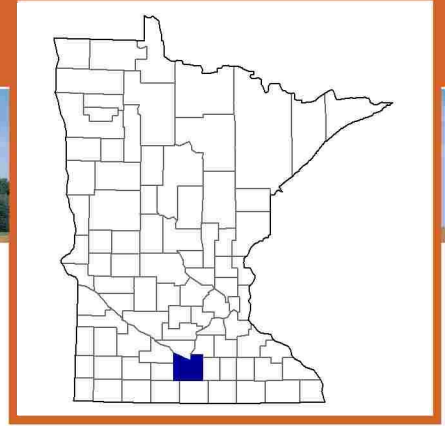
## Blue Earth County, Minnesota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

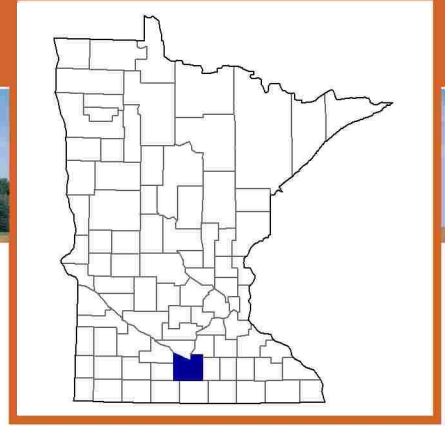


## Blue Earth County, Minnesota Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

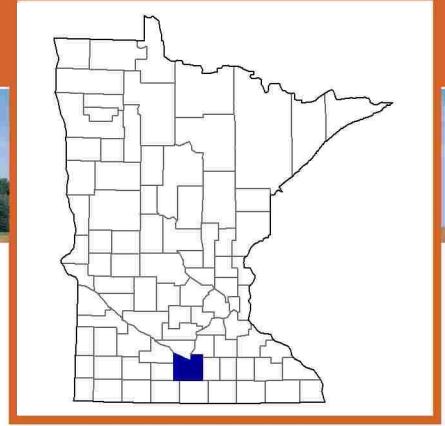

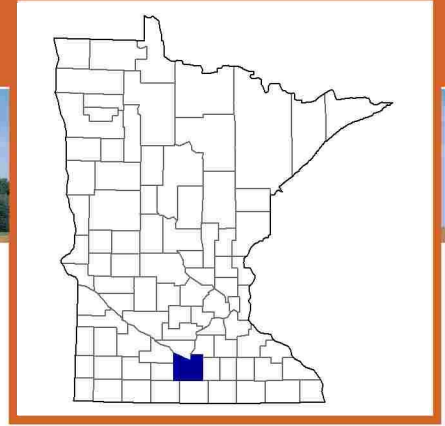


## Blue Earth County, Minnesota Farms with White Producers<sup>a</sup>

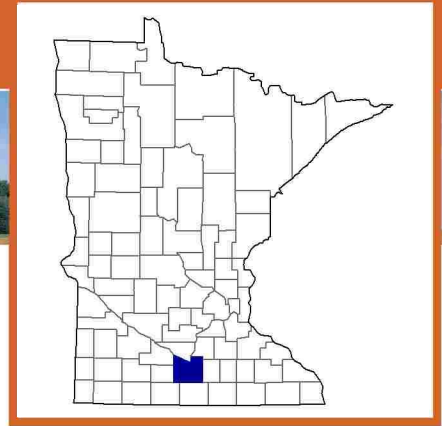
