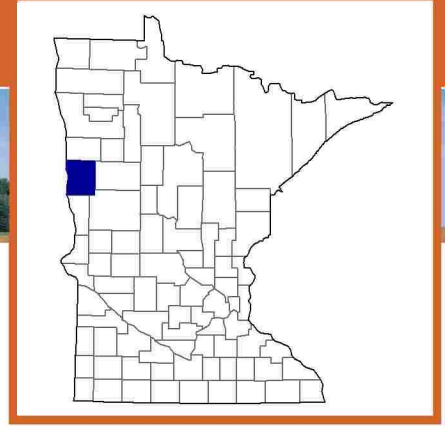


## Clay County, Minnesota Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

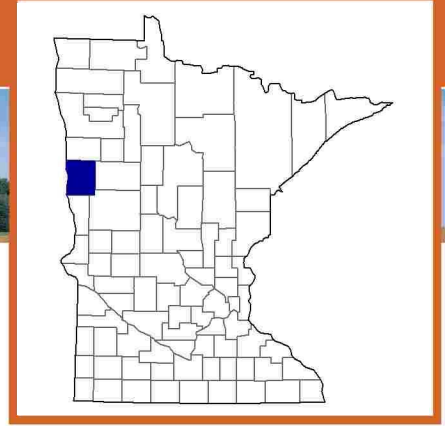


## Clay County, Minnesota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

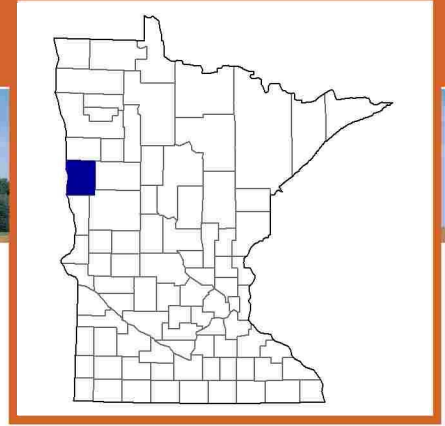

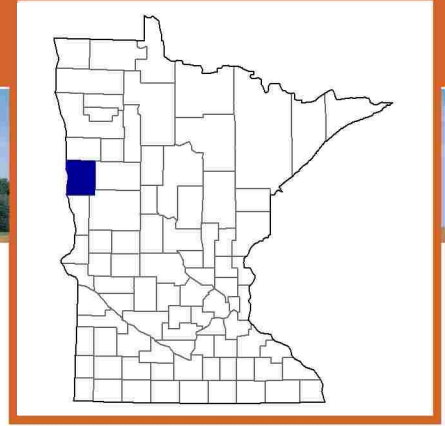

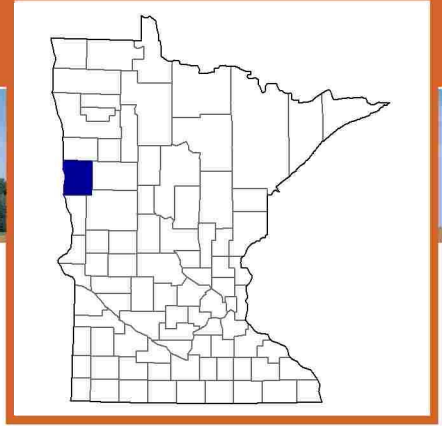

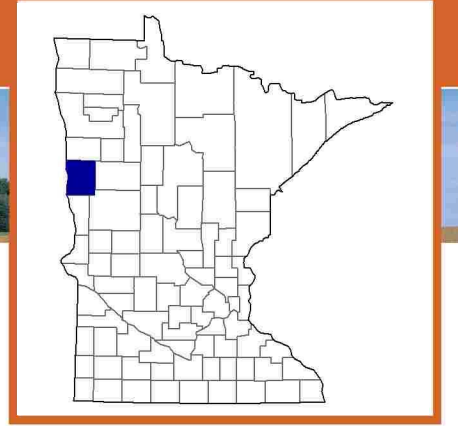
