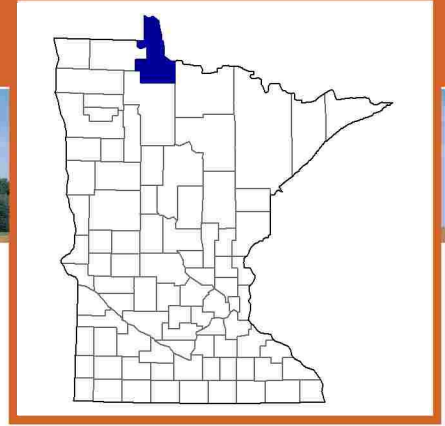

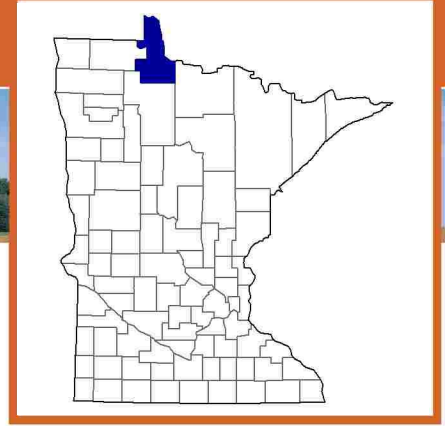

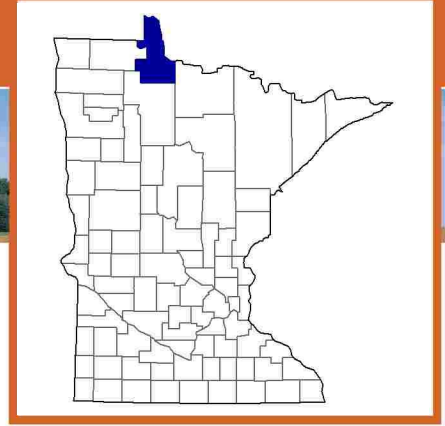

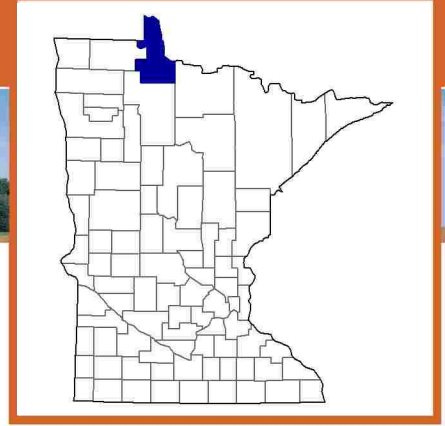

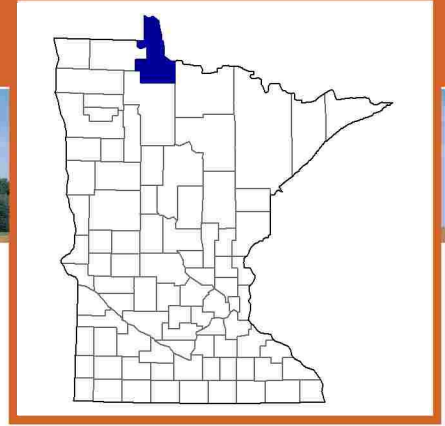

Lake of the Woods County, Minnesota Farms with White Producers^a

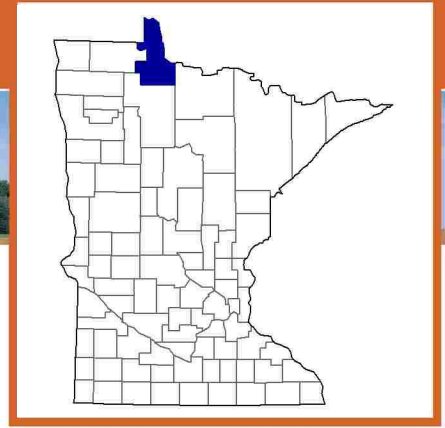
