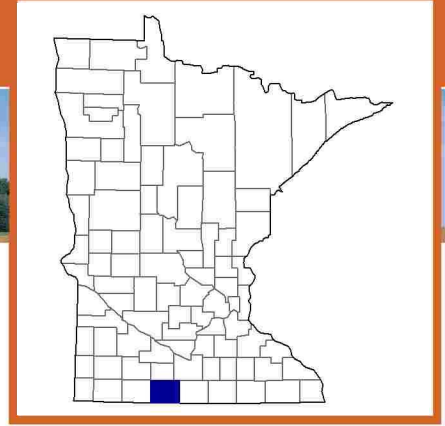

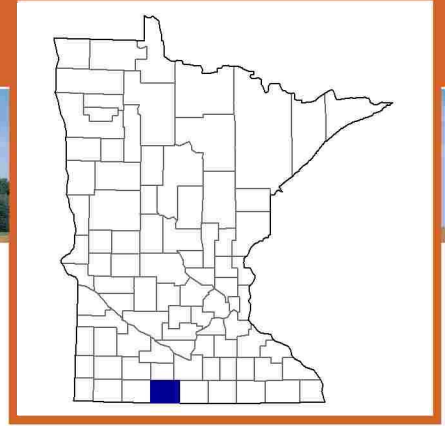
## Martin County, Minnesota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

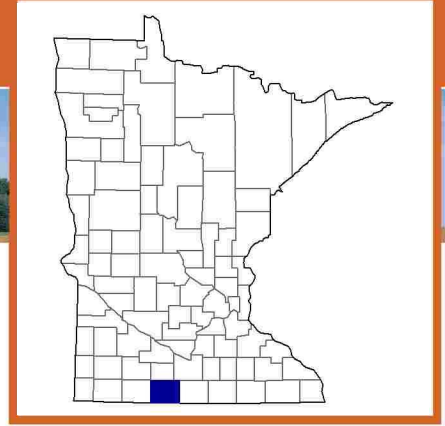


## Martin County, Minnesota Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

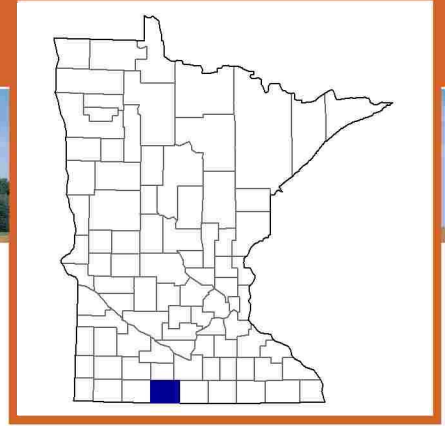

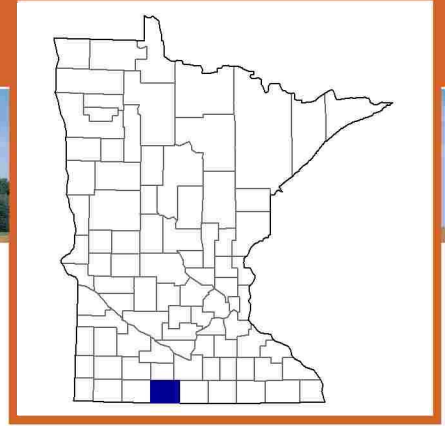


## Martin County, Minnesota Farms with White Producers<sup>a</sup>

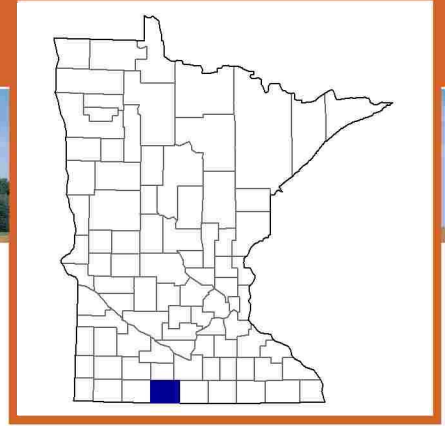
