

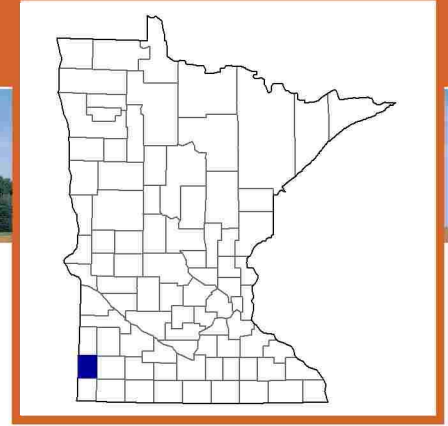

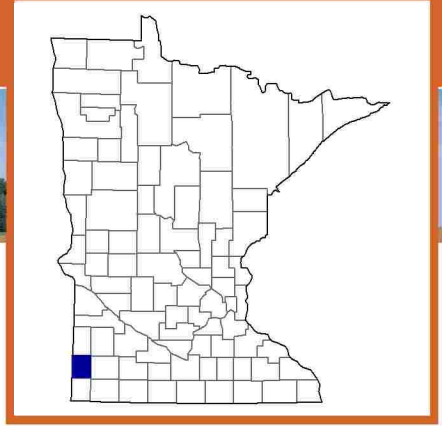


Pipestone County, Minnesota Farms with Asian Producers^a

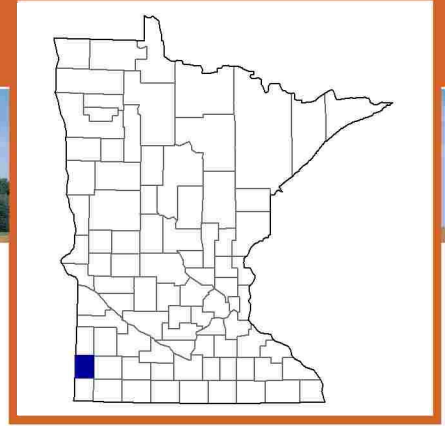

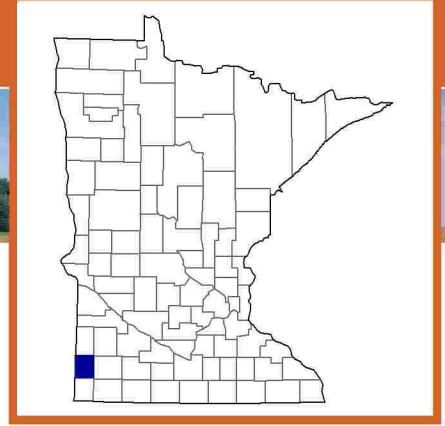

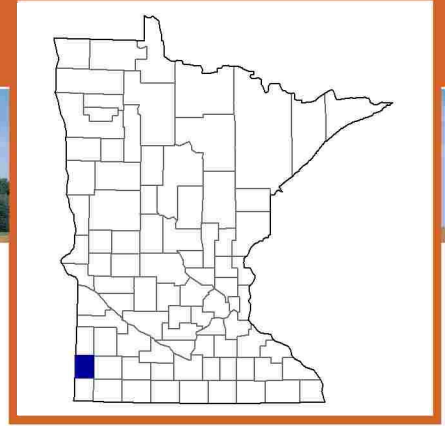

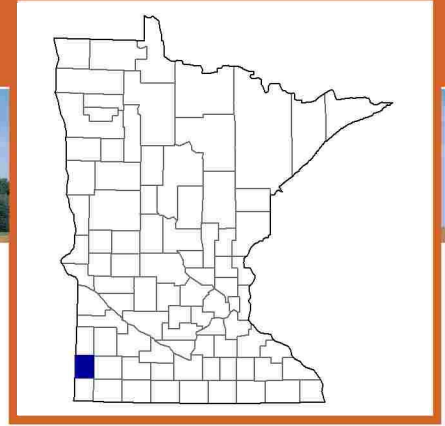
