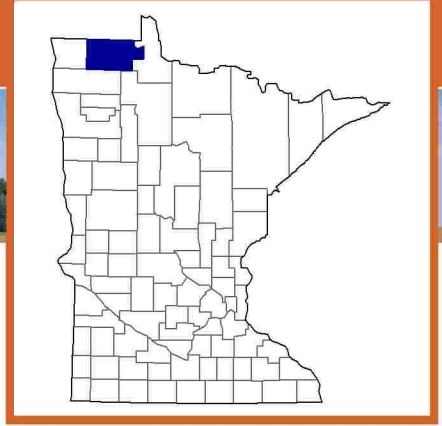

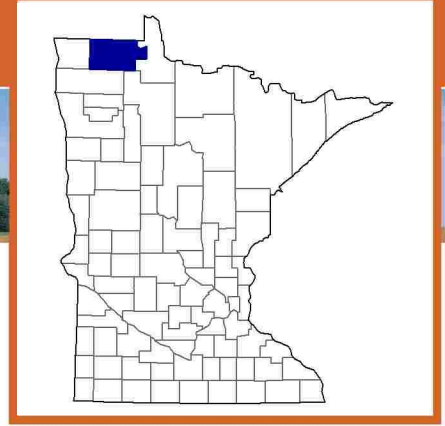


## Roseau County, Minnesota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

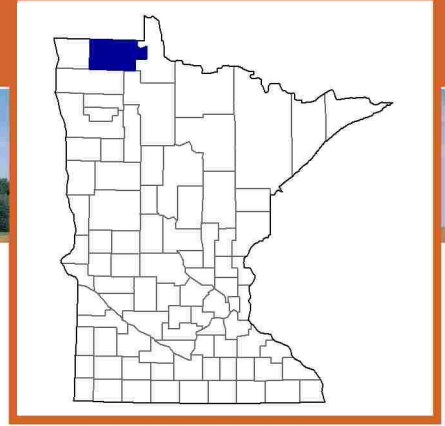


## Roseau County, Minnesota Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

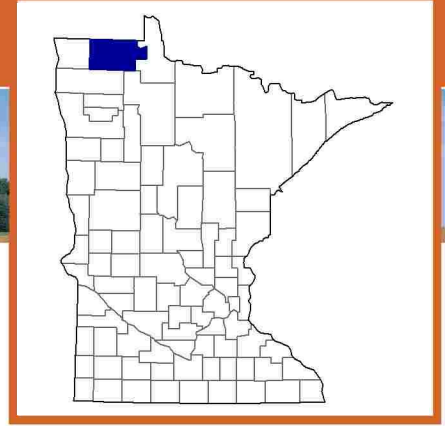

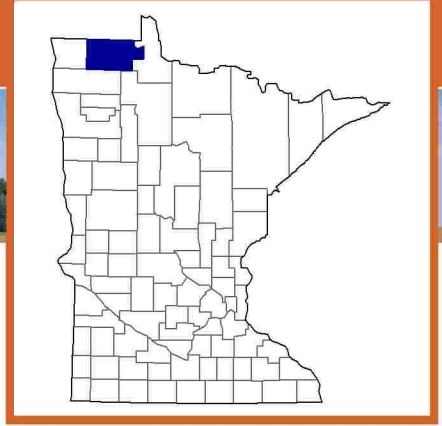

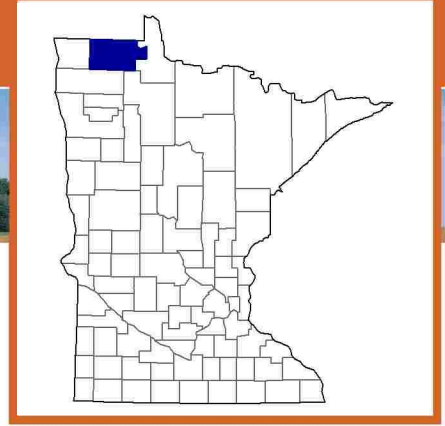
