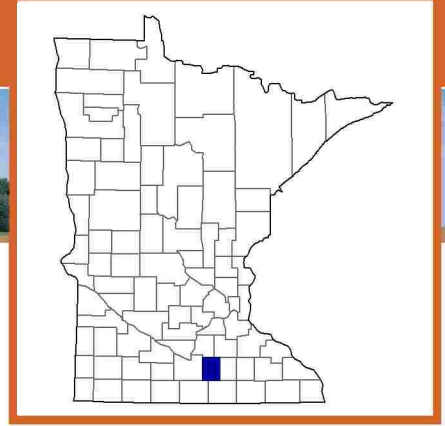

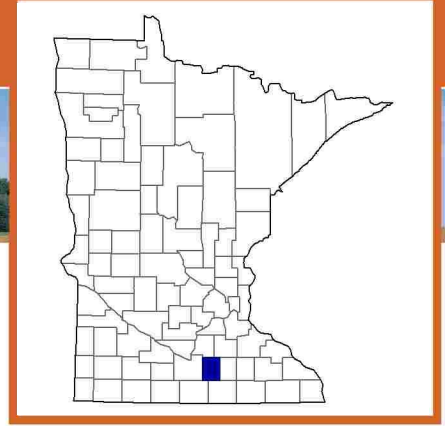


## Waseca County, Minnesota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

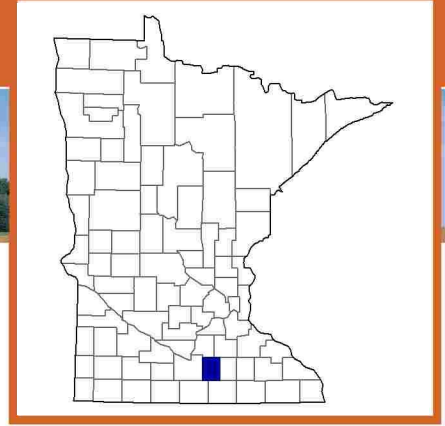

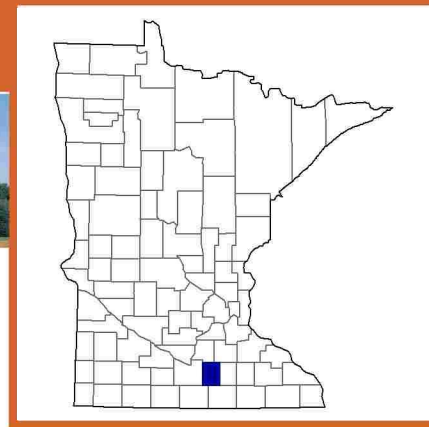

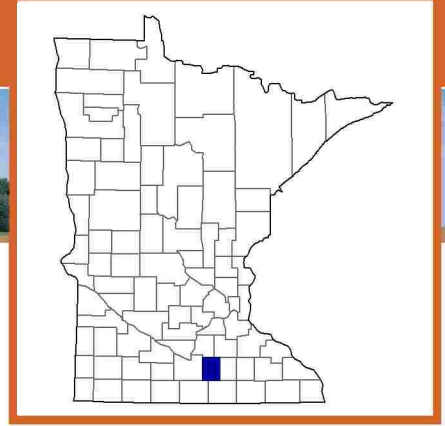

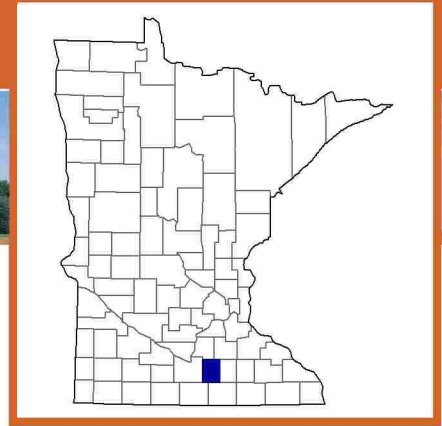
