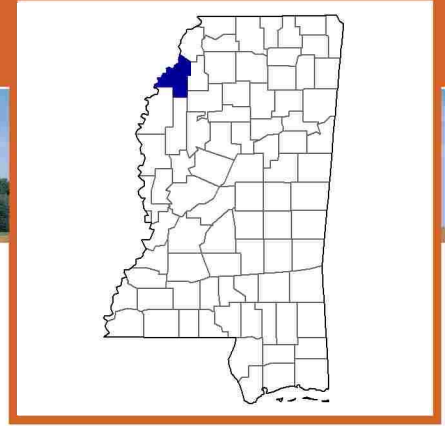


Coahoma County, Mississippi Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

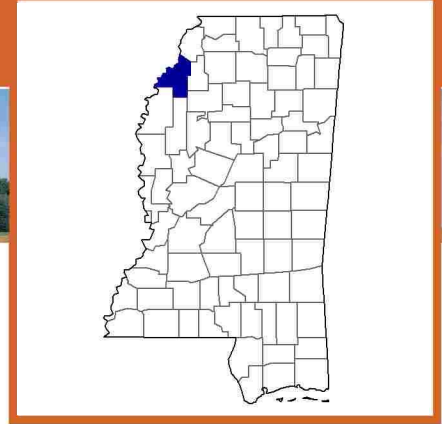

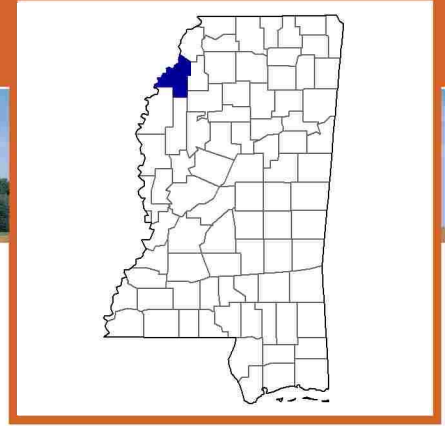

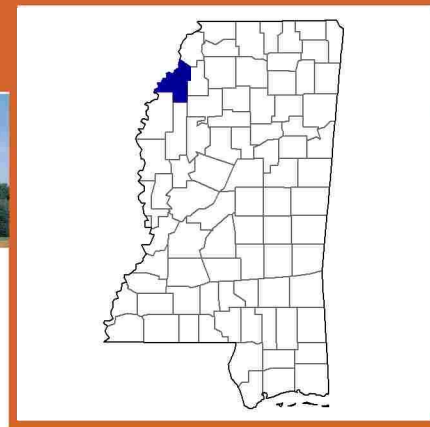
