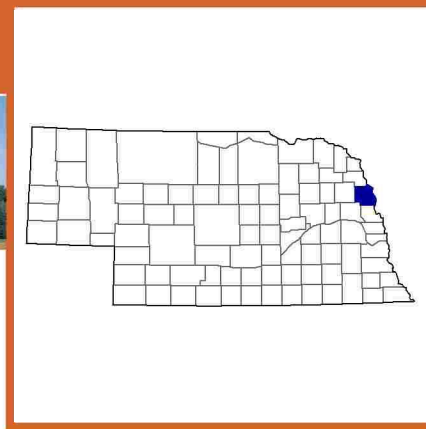


## Burt County, Nebraska Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

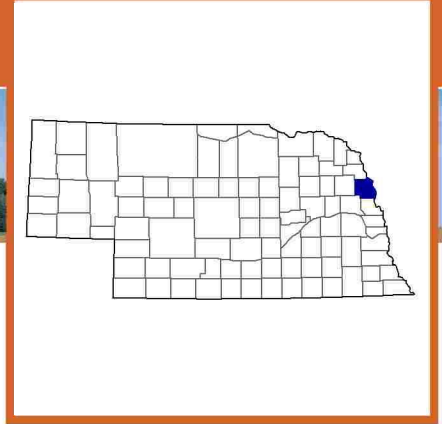


## Burt County, Nebraska Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

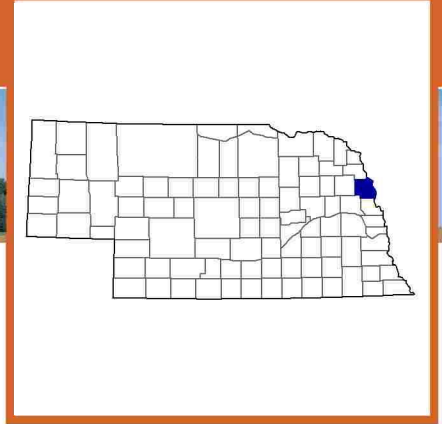


## **Burt County, Nebraska Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>**

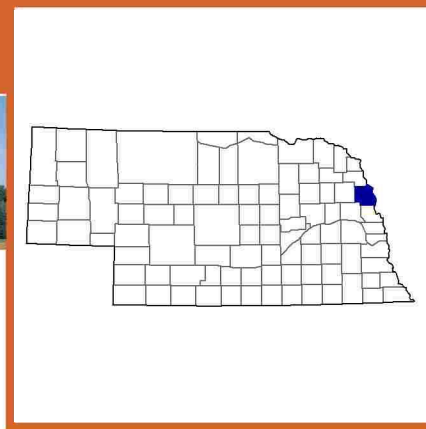

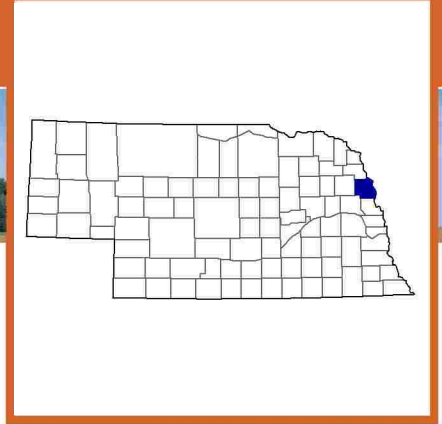

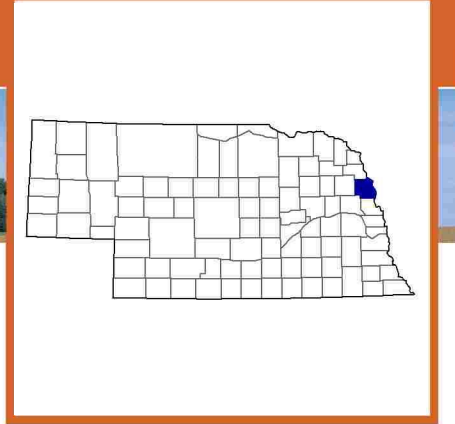
