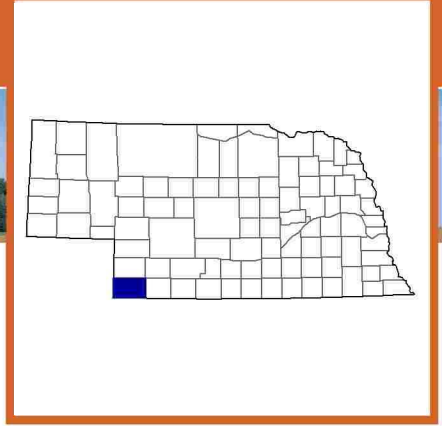

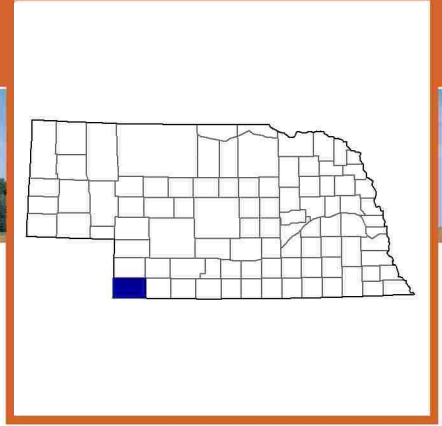


## Dundy County, Nebraska Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

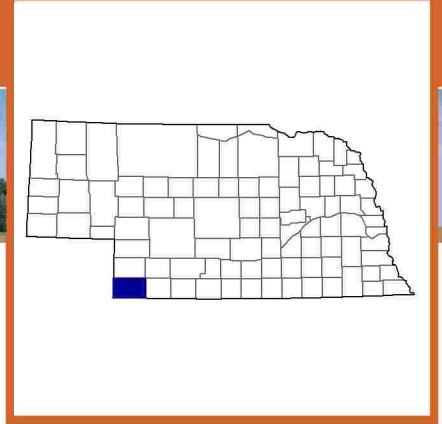


## Dundy County, Nebraska Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

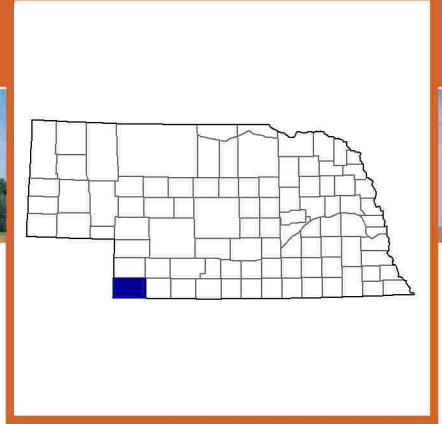

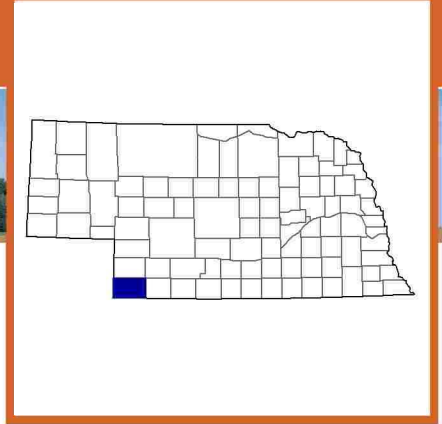

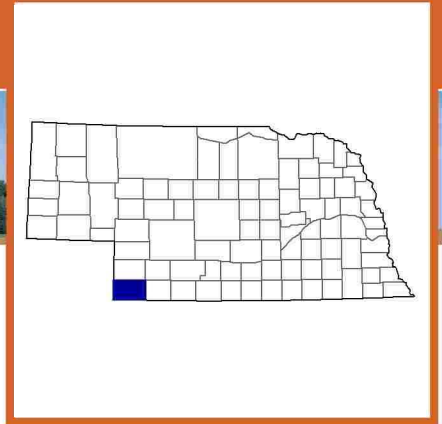
