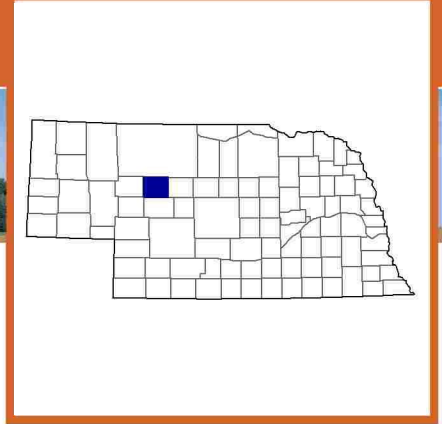

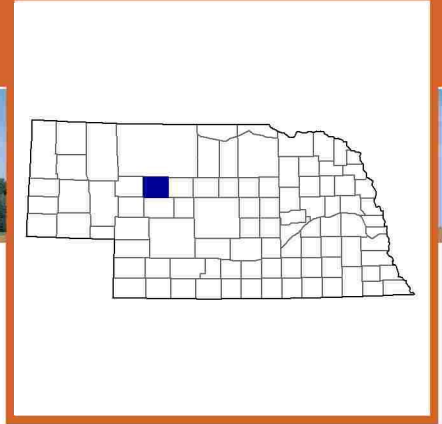


## Hooker County, Nebraska Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

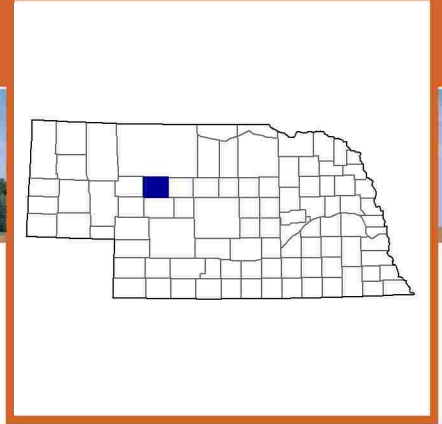

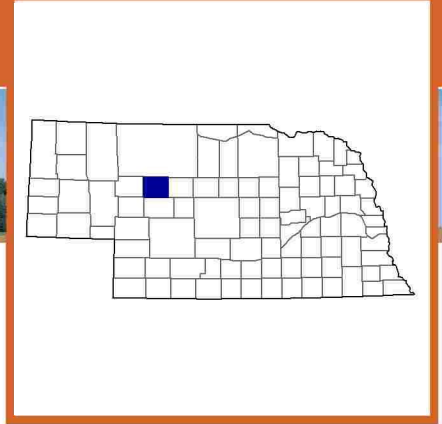

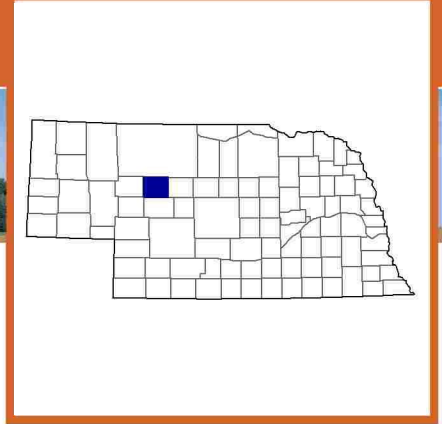

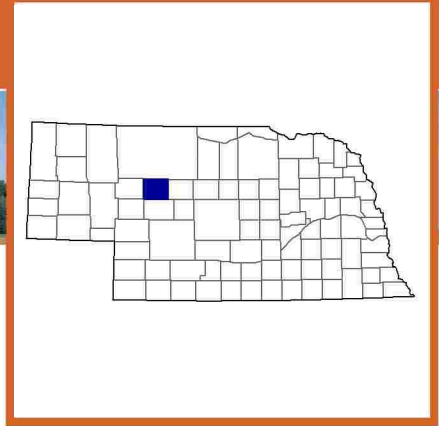
