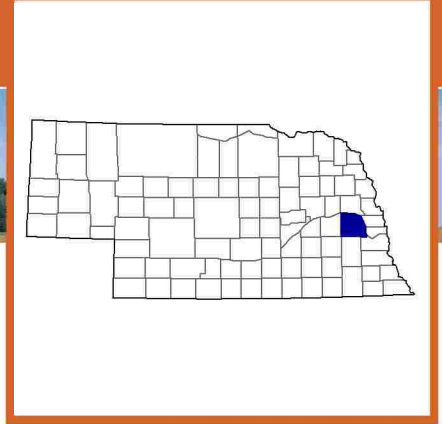

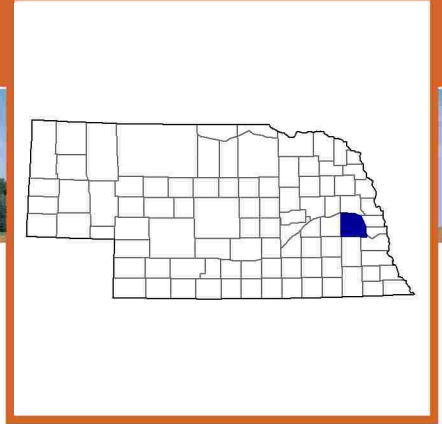


## Saunders County, Nebraska Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

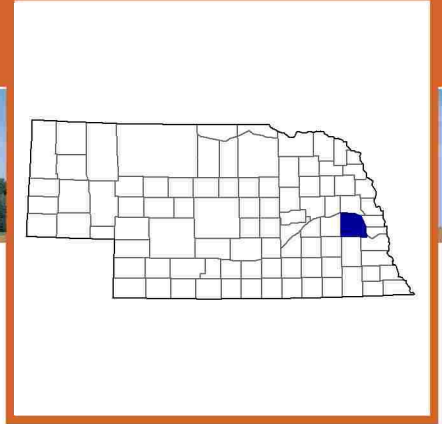


## Saunders County, Nebraska Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

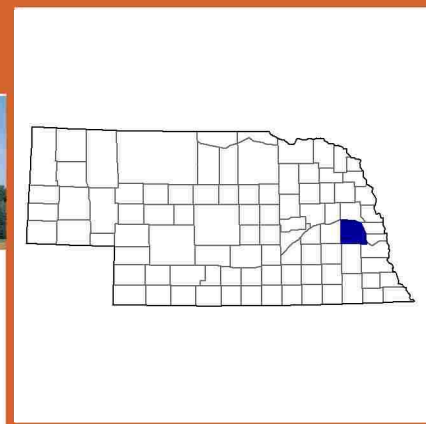
