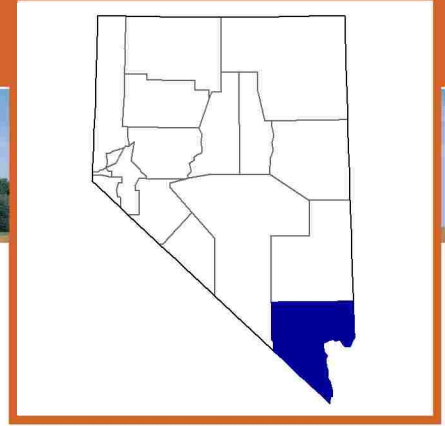




Clark County, Nevada Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

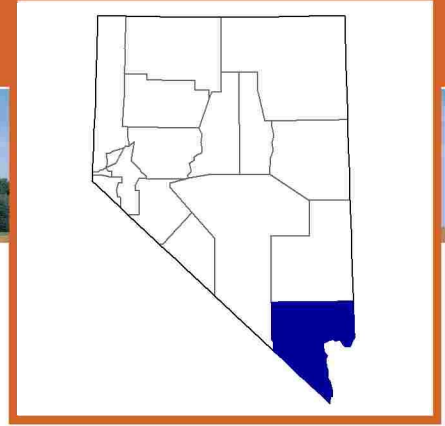

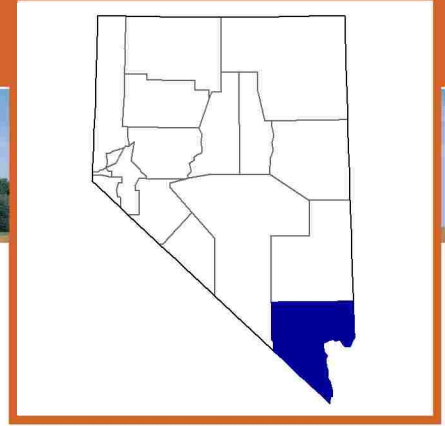
