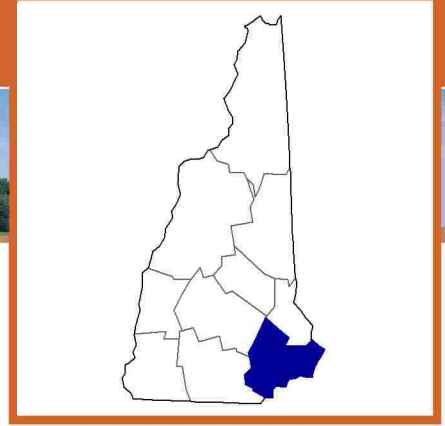


## Rockingham County, New Hampshire Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

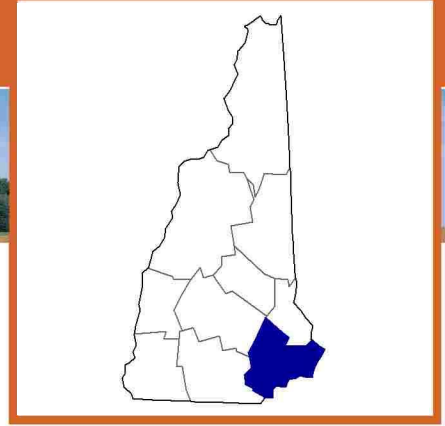


## Rockingham County, New Hampshire Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

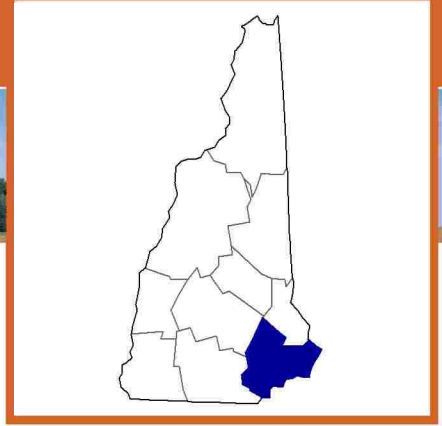


## Rockingham County, New Hampshire Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

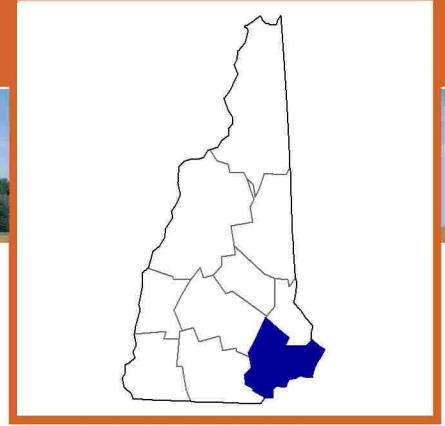

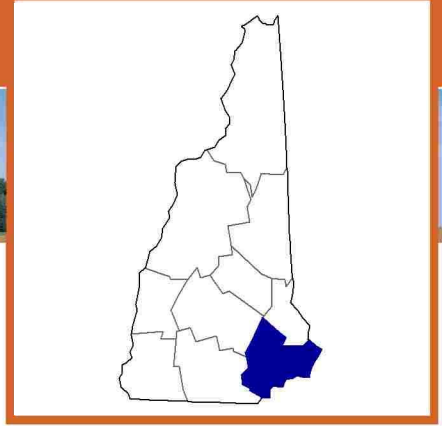

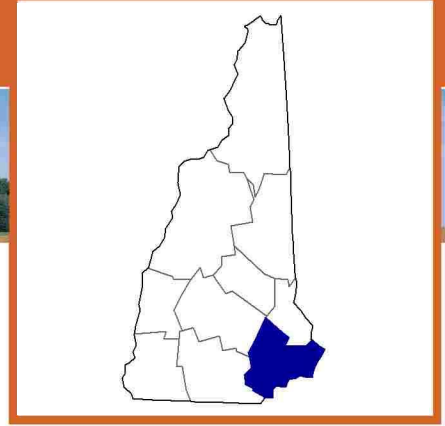
