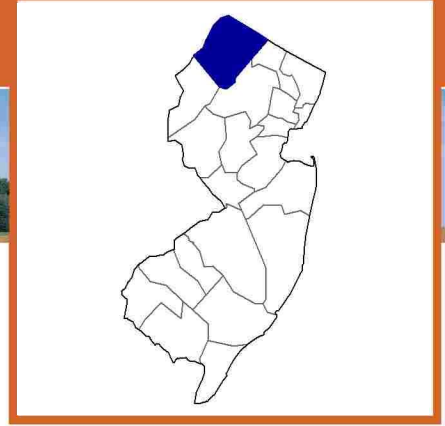

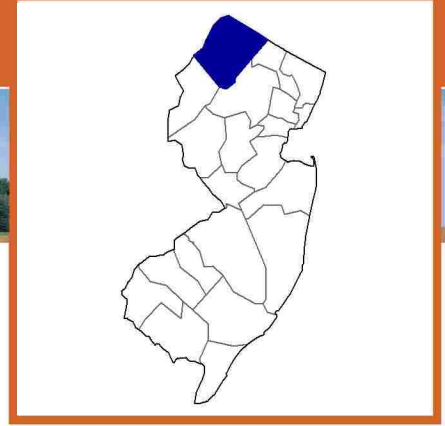


## Sussex County, New Jersey Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

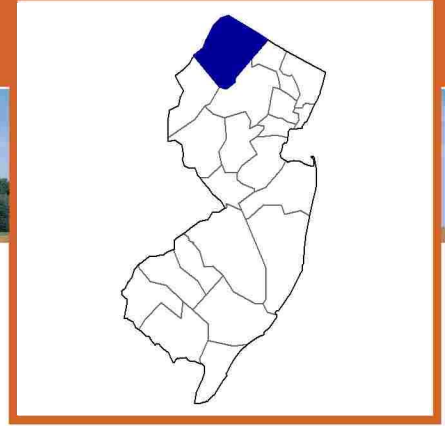


## Sussex County, New Jersey Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

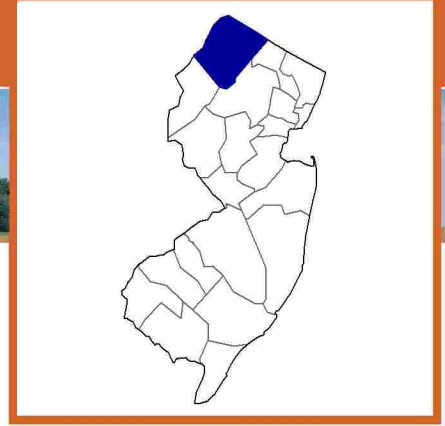

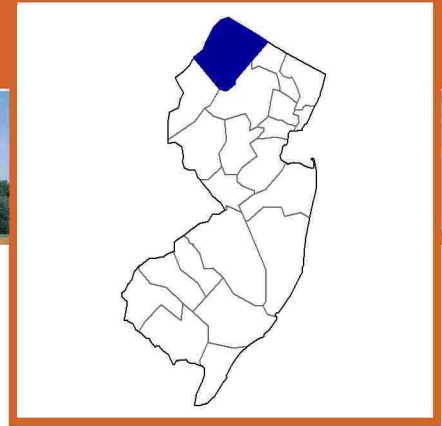

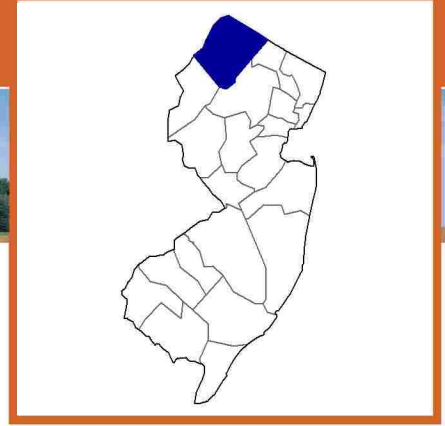
