

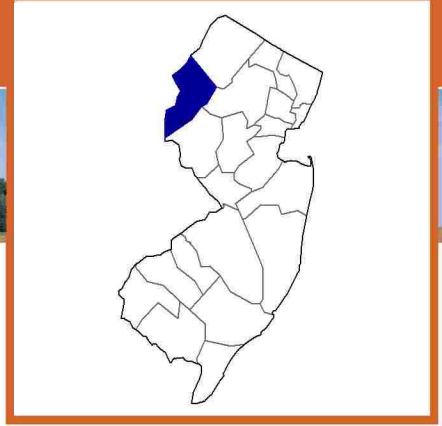


## Warren County, New Jersey Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

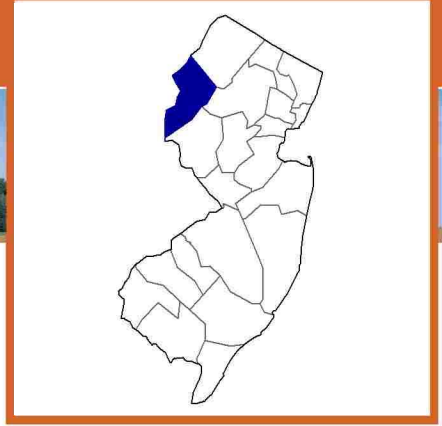

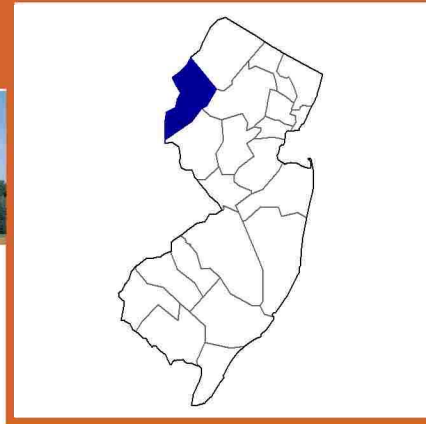
