


Hidalgo County, New Mexico Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a







Hidalgo County, New Mexico Farms with Asian Producers^a






Hidalgo County, New Mexico Farms with Black or African American Producers^a






Hidalgo County, New Mexico Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Producers^a




