


### Union County, New Mexico Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>






## Union County, New Mexico Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>


## Union County, New Mexico Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Producers<sup>a</sup>




