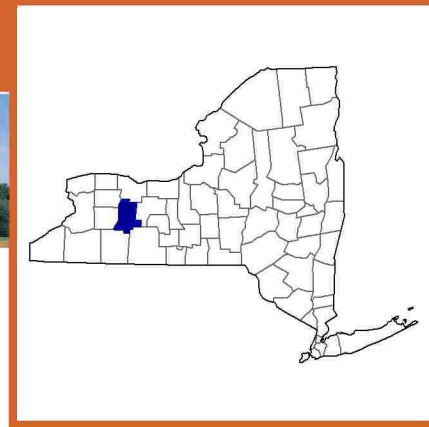


## Livingston County, New York Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

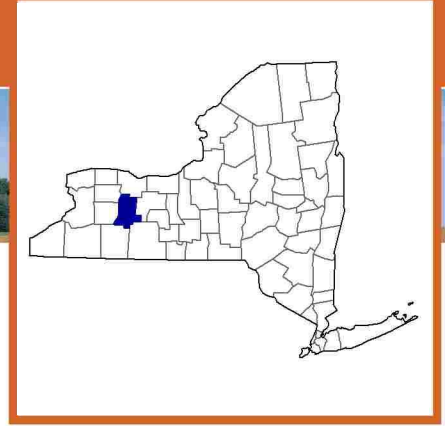


## Livingston County, New York Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

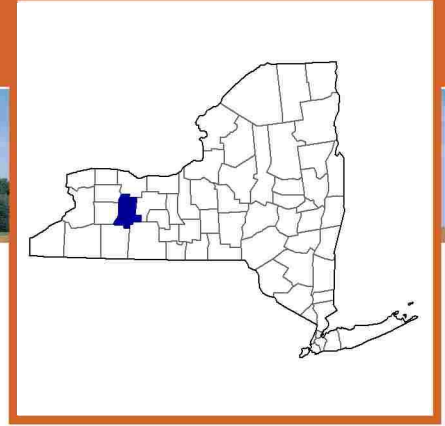


## Livingston County, New York Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

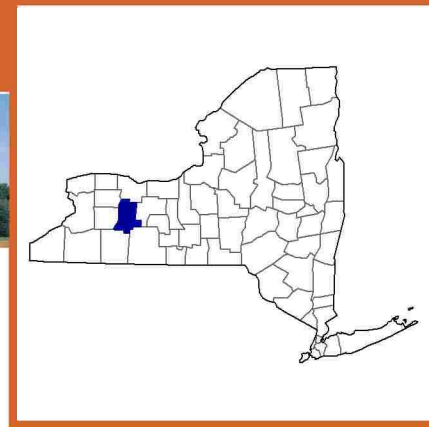

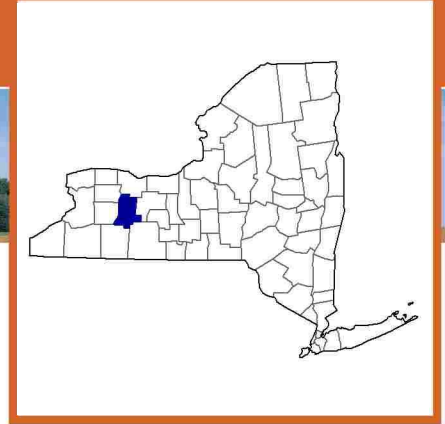

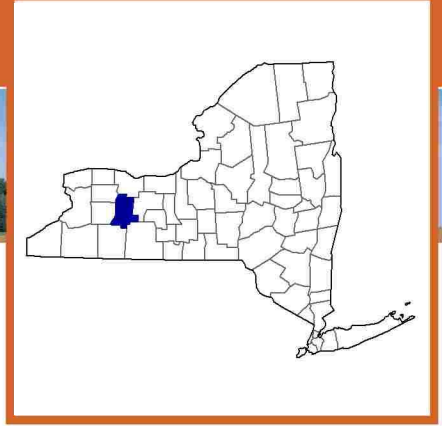
