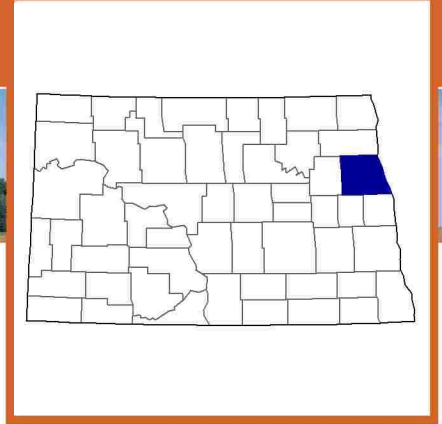

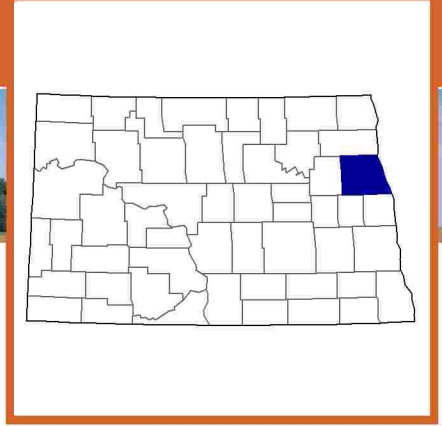

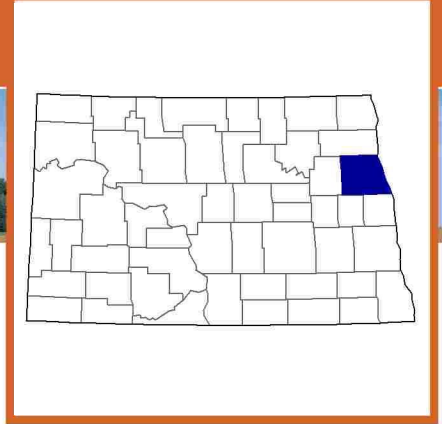

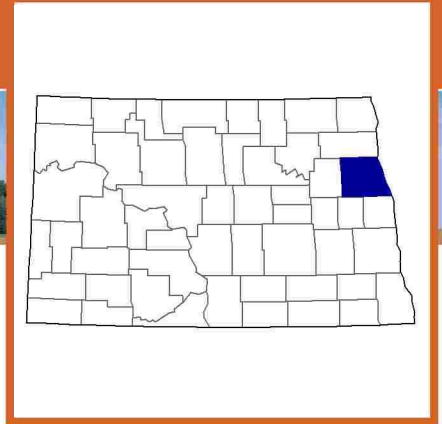

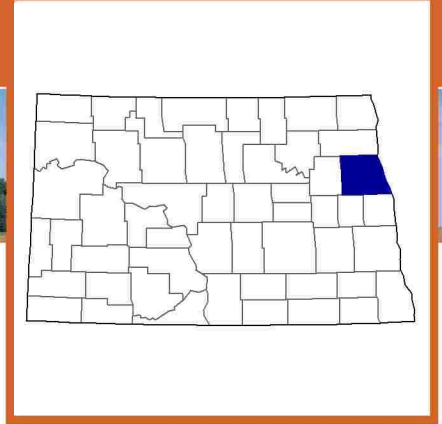

Grand Forks County, North Dakota Farms with White Producers^a

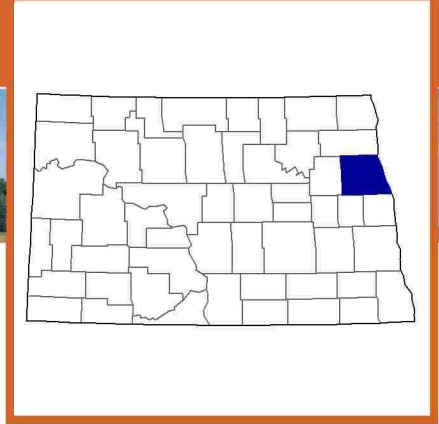
