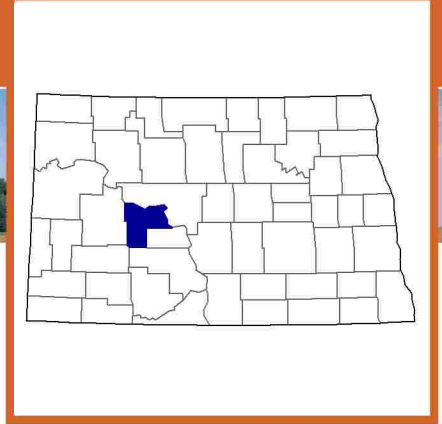

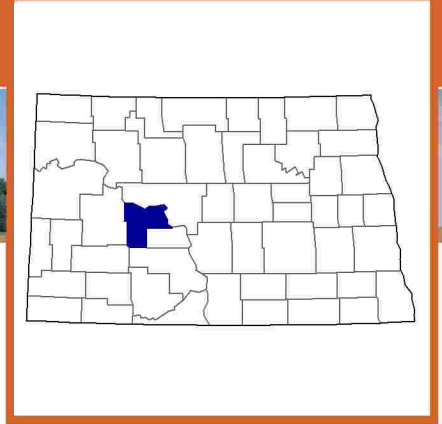

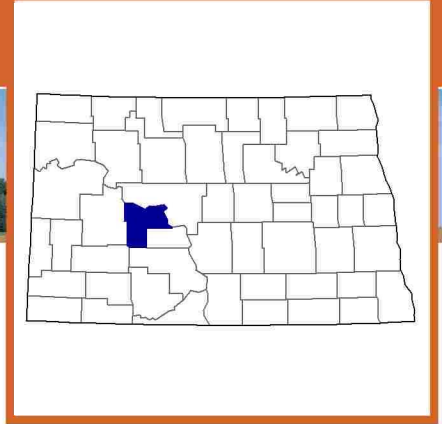


## **Mercer County, North Dakota Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>**

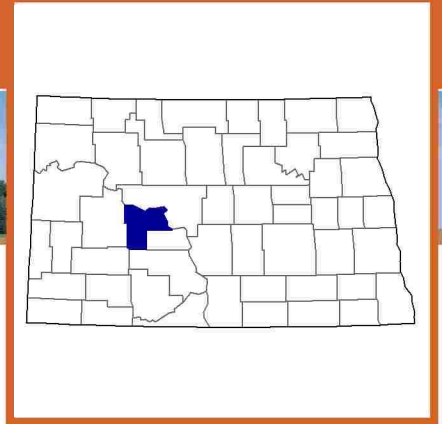

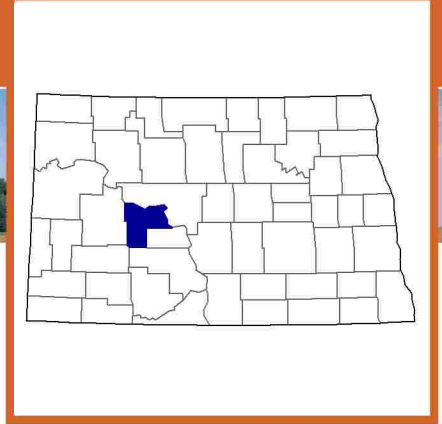

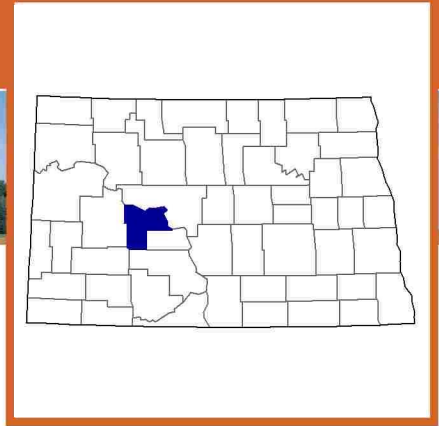
