

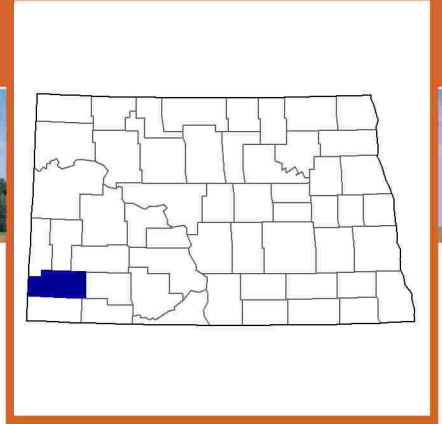

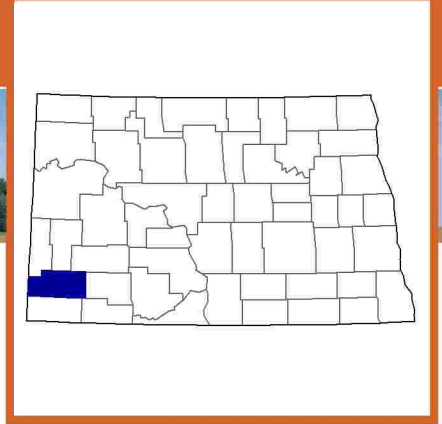


Slope County, North Dakota Farms with Asian Producers^a

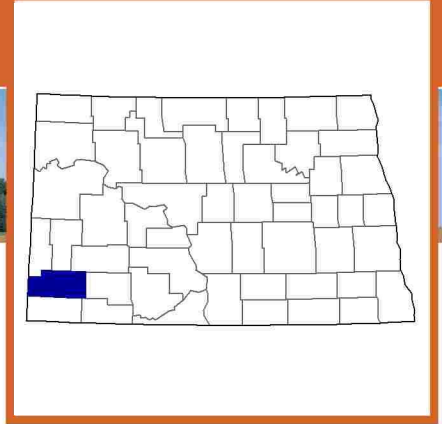

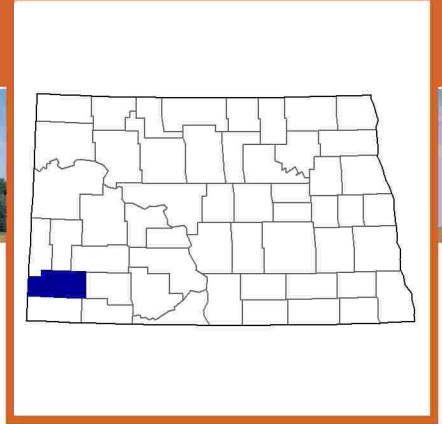

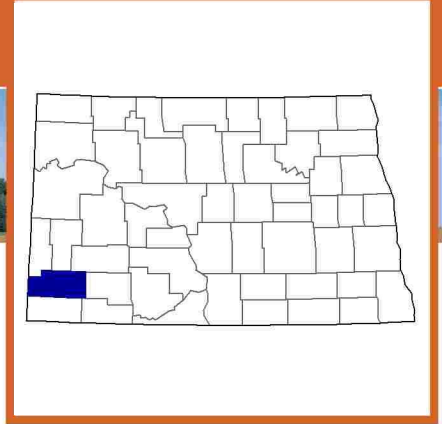

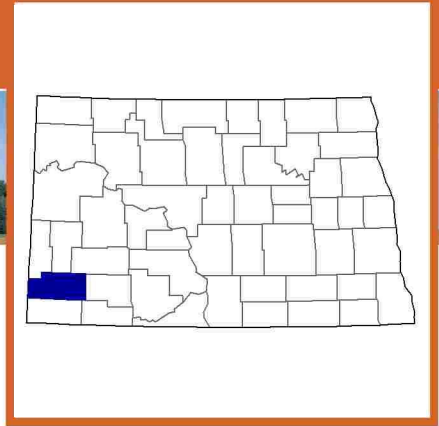
