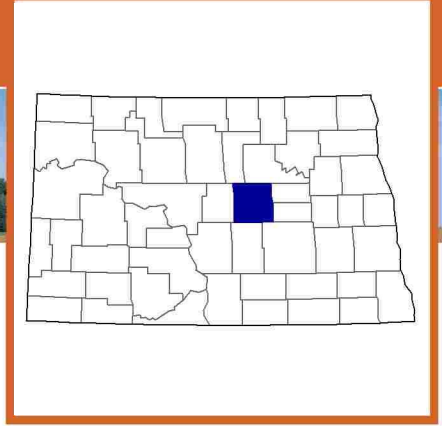

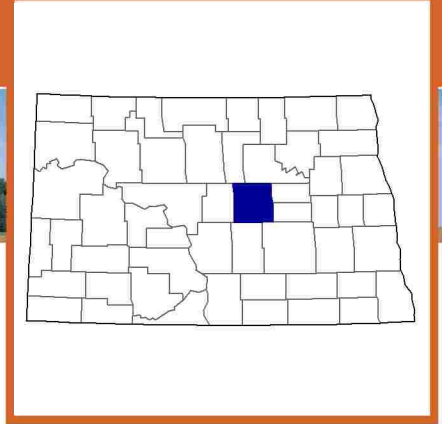


## Wells County, North Dakota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

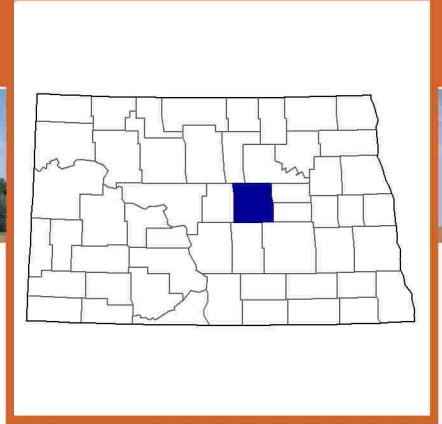

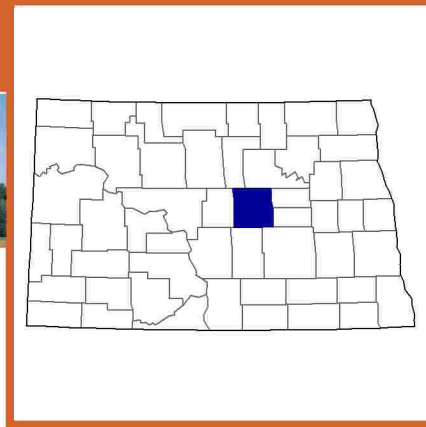

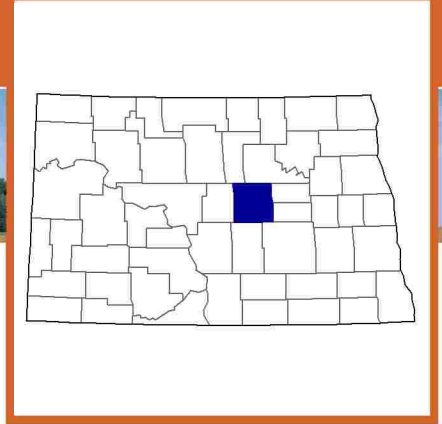

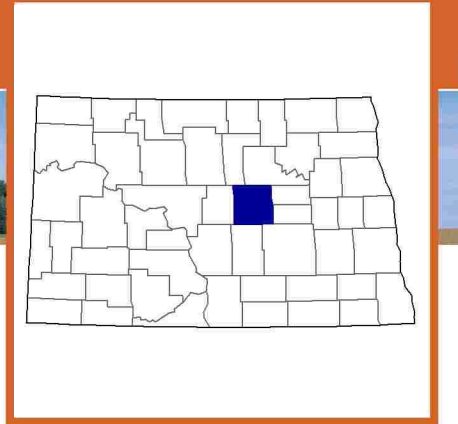
